The Chevy Vega

It was "Car of the Year". Many of them had serious rust issues especially in northern climates.

The AMC Gremlin was an interesting new car. Some hated, it some loved it.

The Ford Pinto is accused of exploding in rear collisions.

Unfortunately it is true in some circumstances that the Pinto had problems where its gas tank can be pushed into the <u>too-small rear crush space</u> during rear end collisions, thus igniting a gasoline fire.





The Chevy Corvair was falsely accused by Ralph Nader in his book for the rear swing axle causing the car to flip over in tight fast turns.

Alas, this is not completely false. The earliest Corvairs had excessive roll, which was modified in later editions. The aftermarket offered a variety of handling fixes for the Corvair, including anti-roll bars, decambering kits, and camber compensators. Chevrolet followed suit in the fall of 1961, introducing an optional heavy-duty suspension package, RPO 696. The Vega project ending in 1965 is a beautiful car.

Many enthusiasts restore the Vega and introduce fantastic upgrades.






