The first draft will then be fine-tuned. The final essay may need up to 5 revisions on the 1st draft.

Comprehensive packs are primarily for students looking to get into the Top-100 Global Schools, and these packs cover detailed review of resume, achievements, SWOT analysis, goal setting, career highlights, extracurricular activities and other parameters of the candidate. The SOP pointers are given to the candidate after this rigorous analysis and student works on his or her draft/write-up next. This 1st draft is then analysed and reanalysed and fine-tuned. It may take up to 10 revisions to make it the best version of the first draft, so time is essential to make it work. This is usually recommended for students who are applying to multiple top graduate Schools in India and abroad. Usually premier graduate Schools will ask a student to write their SOPs / essays on 2-5 topics. The suitability of profile of a candidate for a program is assessed by the admission committee after careful analysis of all these write-ups along with GMAT, CAT or some other test scores. Candidates will also be offered extensive support in drafting their CV.
