I <u>Ne Power</u>, on behalf of the free citizens from the Province of <u>NEW Food Mand</u>, openly express the desire, the free will, and the resolution to enter in to a free union in the Kingdom of the Canada *De Jure* for the aforesaid Province, under the Constitution of Canada(1867-1982), as per the dispositions stipulated within that document.

As described at the Quebec Conference, The Seventy-Two Resolutions (October 29, 1864), I agree, on behalf of the free citizens of Area to be represented under one General Government, charged with matters of interest to the whole country. The future prosperity of a United Kingdom of Canada will be promoted by a Federal Union under the Crown, provided such Union is achieved on principles, equitable and just, to all Provinces.

Be it known that the above mentioned United Kingdom of Canada is constituted under the Crown of Canada, the Great Seal of Canada, and the Great Seal of the aforesaid Provinces, by and for all of the citizens of the country called Canada, for the common good, as well as for the right government, under the formation of a non-registered public society.

I freely and willingly sign, on behalf of the citizens of the aforesaid Province, the official Act of Union, to Federate the Kingdom of Canada De Jure.

Act of Union for Canada;

We, free citizens from the Province of MElwfowal Land we openly express the desire, the free will as well as the purpose to contract a free union in the Kingdom of the Canada dejure for the aforesaid Province, under the Constitution of Canada (1867-1982), as per the dispositions stipulated in it

As described at the Conference of Québec as well as the Resolutions of the aforesaid conference of October 10, 1864, represented under Legislative Federal Assembly, with all the Provinces of Canada united in the bosom of the federation.

Moreover, it is clear that the aforesaid Federation is constituted under the Crown of Canada, with the affixing of the Great Seal of Canada, under the Great Seal of the aforesaid Provinces, by and for all the citizens of the country called Canada, born in Canada for the common good as well as for the right gouvernment, under a form of public society, non registered.

And I freely and willingly sign, for the name of the citizens of the aforesaid Province, the actual official act of union, in the bosom of the Federation of Canada dejure.
