



## **2021 Harry "Rebel" Ryan Scholarship Application**

Pico Ski Education Foundation (PSEF) has a tradition of providing financial support to athletes in pursuit of the highest levels of ski racing. PSEF Founder Harry "Rebel" Ryan is a person who exemplifies the competitive spirit of Pico Ski Club Ski Racing and has inspired generations of Pico Ski Club (PSC) athletes to strive for excellence.

In 2008, PSEF established a scholarship awarded each spring in the name of Harry "Rebel" Ryan in support of "off season" ski training opportunities for Pico Ski Club athletes who have demonstrated a strong commitment to ski racing. Up to two (2) recipients will be selected this year based on their essay submissions and other eligibility criteria. Winners of this scholarship will receive a maximum of \$2000.00 to attend to a ski race-related or dryland training camp during the summer/fall season, or it may be applied towards PSC coaching fees for the 2021-2022 ski season. Please note: The Scholarship must be used before December 15, 2021.

Each candidate is required to complete and submit this application with their two (2) essays for consideration by March 10th, 2021 and must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Pico Ski Club (PSC) athlete who has shown exemplary leadership, hard work, dedication and achievement as determined by his/her Coaches
- Made a commitment to continue to pursue ski racing in their high school and/or college years
- Currently participating in the PSC Race Program at the U14 to U19 level
- Plans to continue their participation in the PSC Race Program in the 2021-2022 season
- Received approval for planned use of Scholarship from PSC Race Director

3. **"My Skiing Experience"**: Write an essay about your experiences or a particular experience in the mountains and skiing, and describe how following this passion has made you happier and more successful life/school.
4. **"What I Hope to Achieve at Camp"**: What are your goals for the next ski season? If you are selected for this scholarship, what do you hope to accomplish at your ski related camp?
