LCEF Natural Disaster Assistance: Here in the North Wisconsin District, spring has burst onto the scene with both blessings and challenges. One of the most unsavory aspects of the season is severe weather, and recently it hit very close to home with tornado damage in the Wausau area that destroyed

dozens of houses and businesses. Additionally, local rivers overflowed their banks and flooded roadways and entire downtowns just weeks ago. Lord, have mercy. But praise God that as you read this, needs continue to be identified and scores of good people are on site working to meet them. I don't often have occasion to mention this, but recent events have prompted me: did you know that LCEF has Disaster Assistance and Response loans to help ministries repair, rebuild and meet their financial obligations when things are at a forced standstill? At minimum, these loans carry 0% interest and no monthly payments for the first 12 months, after which P & I payments are financed at a discounted rate (currently 3.875%) for the remainder of the loan term. Sadly, natural disasters will continue to affect our district – sometimes directly hitting our churches and school buildings. If that's ever the case, please know that Lutheran Church Extension Fund stands ready to assist with these specialized, flexible loans for churches, schools and RSOs.
