Extension Gardening: Soil, Seeds & Transplants, Thursday, April 16th 1:00pm - 3:00pm
At the Marathon County Public Library - Wausau Headquarters, 300 1st St, Wausau. Get ready to garden! The Marathon County Public Library's Wausau Headquarters (300 N. First St., Wausau) is partnering with Extension Marathon County on a four-week series of beginner-friendly gardening programs. This next session, happening on April 16, will focus on all things soil, seeds, and transplants.
