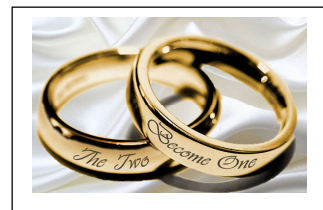

This is a convenient opportunity to receive personalized guidance and enroll for world-class VA health care. **WHO:** The events are open to all Veterans, with knowledgeable VA staff available to answer questions, check eligibility, and complete on-site enrollment—many attendees will leave with their first appointment scheduled. **WHAT TO BRING:** DD214, Income information from the previous year, date of marriage to spouse, dates of birth for dependents, Social Security numbers of dependents **WHY IT MATTERS:** With expanded eligibility, thousands of Veterans across Wisconsin may now qualify for VA health care for the first time. These enrollment fairs provide a convenient opportunity to receive personalized guidance from VA experts and complete enrollment on-site.
