SWING FORE HOPE – 2025

The Foundation proudly celebrated its third annual Swing Fore Hope Charity Golf Tournament at El Paso Country Club on May 5, 2025. The event was a tremendous success, with golf teams selling out quickly and more than 80 golfers coming together in support of a meaningful cause. Thanks to the incredible generosity of participants, sponsors, and donors, Sisters in the Fight was honored to present Texas Tech Health El Paso with a \$15,000 check. These funds will help power medical student-led programs that provide vital breast cancer screenings and life-saving cancer treatments to uninsured women throughout El Paso.

SWING FORE HOPE - 2024

The Foundation held its second annual Swing Fore Hope Charity Golf Tournament at El Paso Country Club on May 6, 2024. Golf teams sold out quickly with over 80 golfers attending the event. Thanks to the golfers and generous donations, Sisters in the Fight presented Texas Tech Health El Paso with a check for \$10,000 to support medical student-led programs that provide breast cancer screenings and other life-saving treatments to uninsured women in the El Paso community and surrounding areas.

COURAGE IS BEAUTIFUL - 2023

Sisters in the Fight Breast Cancer Foundation partnered with JJ's House to provide formal dresses to women who have been on a cancer journey or are currently in treatment. An Instagram giveaway was held with seven El Paso, Texas women being awarded a dress of their choice. The Courage is Beautiful Gala was held on November 3, 2023, at Coronado Country Club in El Paso, Texas. The event celebrated the winners with a celebratory dinner followed by a runway fashion show showcasing the winners in their dresses plus an additional dress. The additional dresses were donated to El Paso High School to support a program that provides donated formal wear to high school girls who cannot afford dresses for school dances and prom.

SWING FORE HOPE - 2023

Sisters in the Fight Breast Cancer Foundation held their first annual Swing Fore Hope Charity Golf Tournament on Thursday, April 6, 2023, at Coronado Country Club, in El Paso, Texas. Sisters in the Fight Breast Cancer Foundation chose Kesem as the recipient of proceeds from the tournament. Kesem is committed to creating a world where every child who has a parent with cancer or who has lost a parent to cancer never feels alone. A check for \$10,000 was presented to Kesem at Rice at their annual fundraising gala two weeks after the tournament. The donation helped fund Camp Kesem summer camp. Families never pay a dime to send their children to Camp Kesem.

BAGS OF HOPE - 2022

Bags of Hope 2022 was a general fundraiser for Sisters in the Fight Breast Cancer Foundation to support the operating costs of the organization. Three designer handbags were raffled during this fundraising event including Louis Vuitton, Gucci, and Yves Saint Laurent.

CUT-A-THON FOR BREAST CANCER - 2022

Sisters in the Fight Breast Cancer Foundation partnered with Chairez Coiffure Hair Salon for a Cut-A-Thon for Breast Cancer. The event took place on Sunday, October 23, 2022. The talented stylists at Chairez Coiffure along with guest stylists offered cuts for men, women, and children, blowouts, pink tape in extensions, and men's clean-ups. Proceeds from the event were donated to a local family on a breast cancer journey to cover medical expenses.

Texas Tech Health EL PASO

We are honored and excited to announce the continued partnership with Texas Tech Health of El Paso. Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center of El Paso will be the recipient of proceeds from this year's tournament.

Sisters in the Fight Breast Cancer Foundation And Texas Tech Health are the perfect pairing to support the El Paso community's cancer warriors. Texas Tech Health provides life-saving outreach, screenings, and treatment to underserved/underinsured women across El Paso.

Every dollar goes to breast cancer screenings and with other local partners, \$180 provides one life-saving screening for a woman in the community. Once screened, if the results are such that the patient needs to be referred to the Texas Tech Breast Care Center, they will receive comprehensive, coordinated care rather than being sent to various providers, surgeons, and specialists.

Two of the key programs run by the campus that offer breast cancer screenings for underserved/uninsured women include:

- Medical Student Run Clinic (a clinic in the Colonia of Sparks) is led by a faculty physician but staffed by Texas Tech's medical students. The majority of patients seen at this clinic are likely to only have access to care via Texas Tech's students. This entry point for access to healthcare is essential for community members in hard-to-reach areas of our county and city.
- A program led by Texas Tech Health's family medicine physician (Dr. Molokwu) and her team of trusted promotors called BEST: Breast Cancer Education, Screening and Navigation program.
