- All players must meet the Men's Club qualifications as defined in the club rules section of our website. To be eligible to compete, the member must have competed at least 4 times on Tuesday within the previous 13 weeks and 10 times in the preceding 12 months. The Board of Directors may waive these conditions. These qualifications must be met for both the Gross & Net Championships, but not for KP's and skins.
- All play is to be completed at our normal start time of 8AM on the respective days.
- Players competing for the Club Championship (Gross) will play from the Blue Tees. Players competing
 for the Net Championship can play from the Combo tees. All players competing for the Club
 Championship (blue tees) are also eligible to win the Net Championship, gross place having priority.
 Once selecting the blue tees to qualify for the gross championship, the blue tees must be played for
 both rounds.
- Everyone is to play the ball down, unless announced differently prior to play. We will attempt to mark GUR prior to the 20th.
- Bunkers will be played as follows:
 - A player will be allowed to place his ball within 1 club length if his ball is <u>in a footprint</u>. The ball is to remain in the bunker. Consult with your playing competitors prior to moving your ball.
- We will use a player's Handicap Index as of September 19th per the SCGA report provided to us. The same handicap will be used for both rounds.
- Foursomes will be picked by our Tournament Director as follows:
 - Day 1 will be by gross and net flight and by Handicap Index.
 - Day 2 will be in reverse order of our Day 1 leaderboard. Lowest Scores last.
 - Day 2 Gross & Net leaders will play in the last groups.
- Buy in:
 - <u>\$30 will be required on Day 1</u> (Sept. 20). This will be a \$15 buy in for each competitive round (Sept. 20 & 22).
 - A \$5 skins game will be optional each day (\$10 for both days). Payable on the first day of the event for a total of \$40.
- Men's Club Contribution:
 - The Men's Club will add \$200 to the prize pool for the Gross & Net payouts.
 - i.e., If 30 players enter at \$30 each the pool will be \$900. The Men's Club will contribute another \$200, making the pool \$1100. Of course, this amount will change depending on the number of players entered. The \$200 contribution will remain the same.
- Payouts
 - KPs will be paid each day at \$20 each.
 - Skins, if entered, will be paid each day.
 - Gross & Net winners will be paid on the <u>total of the 2 days</u> (no payout for Sept. 20).
 - 2 Gross & 5 Net winners will be determined as follows:
 - 1st Gross.
 - 1st Net, from remaining players.

- 2nd Gross, from remaining players.
- 2nd Net, from remaining players.
- 3rd Net, from remaining players.
- 4th Net, from remaining players.
- 5th Net, from remaining players.
- No player can win multiple times in the Gross / Net game.
- It's anticipated that 25-30% of the field will compete in the Gross game, therefore there will only be 2 Gross payouts and 5 Net payouts. Again, anyone competing for the Club Championship from the blue tees is eligible to win the Net Championship.
- 1st place in each of the Gross & Net Championships will be determined by the playoff defined below. All other ties, for 2nd – 5th place, will be determined via our standard cardoff.
- Playoffs
 - In the event of a tie for 1st place Gross, and/or Net, a sudden death playoff will be conducted as follows:
 - Players will play each other starting on hole #18, followed by holes #1, #2, #3, & #18 as needed until a winner is determined.
 - Handicap strokes will apply in any Net playoff.
- Prizes
 - There will be a tee prize available to all players on Day 1.
 - In addition to prize money, the Gross & Net Champion will receive a prize, to be displayed prior to the tournament.
 - They will also receive a trophy, and have their names put on the Champion's Plaque in Hawk's Landing.
 - All of the above prizes will be provided by the Men's Club.
 - Both champions will be entered into the SCGA Gross & Net Championships as defined on the SCGA website. The Men's Club will pay the entry fees (\$150) for both players.
- Non-Qualified Players
 - For those that don't meet the qualifications, as defined on our website, you can still play and participate in the skins & KP game each day for \$5 skins and \$3 KP's
