Redhawk Men's Golf Club Conditions of Competition

Revised 9/11/2024

- 1. Guests will be allowed & encouraged in weekly tournaments. Guests without a current SCGA handicap may play recreationally. Guests with a handicap will be allowed to compete in optional skins competition. Guests will be limited to 4 tournaments in a given calendar year. Guests will not pay the prize fee.
- 2. The Club will conduct two Major Tournaments (President's Cup and Club Championship) each year. To be eligible to compete in these major tournaments the player must have been a member of Redhawk Golfers Club for at least 6 months preceding the tournament and the member must have competed at least 4 times on Tuesday within the previous 13 weeks and 10 times in the preceding 12 months. The Board of Directors may waive these conditions.
- 3. Skins competition is optional. Handicap is actual handicap except there will be maximum of 1 stroke per hole.
- For the purpose of skins, a gross eagle will pay a skin over a net eagle. Gross eagles are very rare and should be rewarded. Two gross eagles on the same hole will cancel each other.
- 4. Unless otherwise determined by the Tournament Director, each player may choose which tees they would like to play from. Player's handicap will be adjusted based on their tee selection.
- 5. First place tie resolution. For our two Major Tournaments (President's Cup and Club Championship), if regular competition ends in a first-place tie, the winner will be determined via a playoff. Playoff holes will be determined by the Tournament Director. For all other golf games/tournament first place tie resolution, we will use a Cardoff procedure to determine the winner.

Cardoff Procedure: In the event of a tie for 1st place, the SCGA standard cardoff procedure will be used, 1st place only.
