Handicap Update,

As your handicap chairman part of my responsibility is to review the weekly scores posted after our Tuesday weekly tournaments. A couple of observations are in order along with a couple of simple recommendations.

When you are posting your score in the GHIN system, via the app or online, if you post the same day that you played, then the date of play will default to today. If you do not post on Tuesday or after you play a round and post one or two days later, take a second to change the date shown on the GHIN app to the actual date you played. For example, it is fairly common that a Tuesday score is posted on Wednesday but one forgets to change the date to Tuesday. Also, if you played from a different set of tees than the previous time, double check that you select the appropriate tees that you played from. We usually play from the Combo Tees but if you played from the White Tees previously, the GHIN will default to the white tees since it defaults to the previous round tees. Not a big deal but it creates some confusion when comparing the Tuesday scores to our Spreadsheet because your date of play is shown on a different day

Another area where discrepancies occur is when players post their gross score rather than their adjusted score not considering any holes which may have exceeded net double bogey for handicap purposes. This accounts for the majority of posting errors. The easiest way to



handle this is to utilize the **GHIN** app and post your score "hole-by-hole". You enter your gross score for each hole, the app will automatically advance to the next hole where you enter your score for that hole. Also, it will adjust for any hole where you exceed "Net Double Bogey". You do not have to figure it out yourself. Try it once and I think you will agree how easy this method is and the most accurate way to post. Of course, you always have the option to adjust manually and post your total score. Quite honestly, most of the Tuesday gang has found that posting hole by hole is really easy. If you have questions about posting hole by hole or understanding how net double bogey works, please contact me or any board member. We will be happy to explain and show you how it works.
