DUMPSTER DAYS

The always popular Andover Glen Dumpster Days is scheduled for June 11&12. This service is for Andover Glen residents only. The dumpster will be dropped near the entrance of Andover Glen Park on E. Layton Dr. sometime on Saturday morning. Sorry, exact time cannot be given. Please take note of the following restrictions on what cannot be placed in the dumpster:

- Tires
- Liquids
- Paints/Solvents
- Hazardous Chemicals
- Pesticides/Herbicides
- Batteries
- Fluorescent lightbulbs
- Appliances
- Electronics
- Propane tanks

Additionally, please load the dumpster from the back to the front and break down any large items and tree branches before loading. Please do not load the dumpster above the top of the container. Be careful around the loading area and do not climb into the dumpster.

We will have Electronics Recycling and Document Shredding available from 11 am to 1 pm. on Saturday, June 11 only. Please note that there is a \$20 fee per CTR Monitor/Tube TV, and \$40 fee for all TVs over 22 inches. Rear projection TVs are not accepted. Data destruction is \$5 per hard drive. There is no charge for CD players, VCRs, stereos, printers, tape decks etc. Please plan ahead as the Electronic Recycling and Document Shredding are available for the hours listed.

COMMUNITY CLEAN UP DAY

This year's Community Clean Up Day is scheduled for Saturday, June 25 from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. This is your chance to give back to the community, have some fun, and meet your neighbors.
