A Message from the AGHA Board President...

Hello everyone, as 2025 closes out and we prepare for 2026, I want to make sure that all Andover Glen homeowners have their calendar marked for January 20, 2026. At 7 pm that evening, a special meeting will be held to discuss the *potential* of bringing a solar garden to part of our Andover Glen park. Two companies, Apollo Solar and EM Energy Services, will be giving a presentation on this potential project followed up by a Q & A session where you as owners will be able to get your questions answered. I've received many emails about this project and your AGHA board has set up a page on the Andover Glen website to give as much information as we have. The page is:

This page is updated regularly, so please check back as new information is added. Of course, we hope you can attend the meeting on January 20 to listen to the presentation and get any remaining questions answered.

You should be aware that it is up to YOU, the full membership of the AGHA, to approve the use of our park for this solar garden. After the meeting on January 20 (which is purely informational) your board will be meeting on January 21. At that board meeting, the board will discuss and vote whether there is enough interest and information to take this solar garden proposal to a full vote of the membership. 67 out of 99 homeowners would need to approve of this project for it to go forward.

Snow Removal Reminder



As a resident or property owner in Aurora, it is your responsibility to keep city sidewalks adjacent to your property free and clear of snow and ice, even though the sidewalks may be behind or outside the rear and side fences and adjacent to any street.

Snow and ice must be removed within 24 hours after a snowfall ends, and 48 hours after a snow emergency is declared by the city.

And the city highly encourages you to be a good neighbor and help those in your neighborhood who may not be able to clear their own sidewalks for whatever reasons. Some day it very well could be you that needs this kind of assistance!

Architectural Change Guidelines



The Architectural Change Committee is responsible for maintaining the integrity of outside changes or improvements in the Andover Glen

community.

The guidelines that are to be followed can be found in Article III of the Covenants and in Section B of the Policies and Procedures.

These can be found on our website, andoverglen.org, in Resources then Covenants and Policies.

In general, the guidelines for homeowners to follow are:

- All outside changes or improvements need to be reviewed and approved by the Architectural committee.
- The committee has 15 days to respond to minor changes and 45 days for major changes as defined in the Policies and Procedures.
- No outside project can begin without approval.
