a rush to store everything away before leaving here.

May 10th 7:00 am I am at Pickles. While I was working up at Mass yesterday I got a call from the South Carolina DPER. The woman told me that everything was in order that she was sending the new title for tradewinds out in the mail today. I am going to have to look back to see when this process began. I remember in my ~~intrested~~ conversation with John Cooper. He said if you have me do this it will cost you a substantial amount of money. You can do this yourself. I explained to him that I did not live in the area and I believed it was more complicated than would

meet the eye.

Sat morning 6am at Pickles

Ever since I got news of the clear title I have been thinking I should be so happy. Instead my mind is telling me else on the road. A new road, an uphill road, and else the news is great a milestone for tradewinds but a whole set of new realitys appear on the radar screen. The boat is still sitting at mooring on the Broad Creek. It is still leaking. Hopefully she will be out of the water safe & sound in Steven Mullers yard sooner than latter.

Weds May 15th

I am sitting on the ferry

boat in Cruz Bay just putting away from the dock heading across to Red Hook, tomorrow I will be back on the Vineyard.

Yesterday I got a text from Michele Jones she told me the title from S.C. D P&R was in the mail. Also she said it was all correct in my name with 113 Greenwood ave address. We got the title free & clear. It took a lot of help from people. It would not have happened without the work Michele did her research - and of course John Townsend Cooper who did most everything else.

thurs May 16th

8:30 am I am sitting at my niece Tabors Kitchen table Her Husband was Chris

gone before I woke up. Olivia other little girl & Camron their little boy are having breakfast. I told Tabor about the title coming through last week. I showed her a picture of the boat and we talked about the future. I had Emailed my sister Patty telling her that ~~that~~ the Lawyer was successful and sent along ~~pics~~ pictures of the title for tradewinds.

Yesterday I got an Email back that said ^{this is} exciting - and a little scary to be honest,

I called Peter Maddock and left a voice mail

Peter is not returning my calls. I left three messages.

Tradewinds has been heavy on my mind.

I texted Clay he said
the Boat was OK and
that he was going to
Ashland NC for a week.

I felt hopeless this
week. With Clay gone I
have no way of knowing
if the Boat is OK.

I called my sister
Michelle. She has lived
in Hilton Head then Bluffton
for 20 some years.

I asked her if she knew
of anyone who could look
out from the pier and tell
me if the boat was still
there. Michelle said ya
no problem. She texted
A friend who lived in the
Condos next to the dock.
He said He would go down
and look.

Weds turned into Saturday
I never got an answer,

Sat May 25th 194

5:00pm I got the dudel
call from Clay. He was
Blunt "your boat is going
down, I am not dealing
with it its your problem
I done with that boat?"
Clay gave it to me hand
and then he hung up.

I am on the Vineyard
I can't see the tradewinds
its 1000 miles to the South
I began to get really anxious
I had Visions of the boat
swamped headed to the
bottom with nothing I
can do. My stomach
began to turn. I began to
run diffrent scenarios through
my Brain. none of them
were good.

I waited until I couldn't
stand it anymore. I kept
Clay asking I I could

call him. I got no response if waited a while longer then I called Clay. He answered. He told me that he had a pump going on my boat but that he was done "I can't deal with your boat anymore" "I don't want to have anything to do with that boat,

SAM

I texted who got back to me. He said I could call early in the morning.

Sunday May 26th

120 - I called

SAM We talked I told him about the situation I asked him if he had any vehicles. He said no he only has the van he drives

I was thinking about flying but the truth is I would not be able to get anything

done, the inflatable is at the storage unit on a trailer I will need to pick it up, set it up at the boat ramp to get out to the boat,

My goals are to first get another solar panel set up with charge controller & batteries a float & Bilge pump that is a whole separate system so if the primary system fails the secondary will come on.

My plan now is to get on the road in the old land cruiser drive down to Hilton Head its a long drive. But I don't have any other options. I need parts & tools to get the work done, I have been feeling overwhelmed ever since I got the phone call about the boat being

in trouble.

May 25th

Oh my God what a roller coaster this has been. Its tuesday night. My plan was to get on the road to South Carolina sooner then latter. I had to jobs to put back together I was running and got most of it done. I havent gotten any sleep for three days. I would dose off then wake up stark with visions of a sunken boat a disaster that made my stomach turn. I tried hard to keep it together even if I got to S.C. before the boat sank I am powerless to really make any real impact the best I could hope for was to put a bandaid on a Bandaid I thought of shooting the holes with foard

I thought about pouring juicy cement into the bottom of the boat, the idea of beaching seemed to risky because if the centerboard was jammed to one side or the other it might just break wide open. I was feeling more & more hopeless, last night was unnerving

This Morning around 7:30 I called ~~Peter~~ Peter Maddock, Peter answered right away He said he hadnt forgotten me, But he just had two weeks from Hell a Filthy for Shrimps Boat Bloke look on the marine Railway took off, He said they had to jack it up to get it straight, I told him that tradewinds was leaking worse and that I was heading

down to do whatever I could. "Don't come" he said I'll handle it, I'll go check on the boat. The trailer is ready and I'll get you hauled out soon.

Weds 5/29 6:30 am

Peter called last night and said the bilge water was under control - that he would regularly check the boat and get it hauled out as soon as possible.

I went to bed and slept straight through.

9:30 pm oh I want that boat out of the water - I texted Clay that Peter told me not to come down He said he was on it and would

get tradewinds out as soon as possible. Clay texted back that yes he had talked with Peter the night before when Peter came out to town. Clay texted that he would keep an eye on it. I wrote out a check to Clay and put it in the mail to pay him back for the new pump & float switch plus some extra for his time,

5/30/19 10:30 pm

I have shifted my prayers from Fox Hole to full fledged Support Prayers for Peter Maddock & Clayton Mills —

6/1 5:30 pm I got a text today during the afternoon from [REDACTED]

5AM

He said he was down launching a boat and that he could see my boat sitting out there.

I texted back thanking him I added that I will feel a whole lot better when its sitting on his lot!

Bring it on his reply

6/12 Its been hard on the brain trying not to go into full fledge worry mode, I texted Peter Maddock on Monday morning he texted back that he would call as soon as he got his head above water.

Around 7:30 pm tonight I got a text from Clay Clay said the boat battery were holding at 12.3. He went on to say that its

been raining heavy for two days and the solar panels need sun, I texted Peter. Clay also said He was leaving Hilton Head for good on Friday so there was not going to be any one around to look after the boat, I relayed this information out to Peter. Time to pray!!!

6/13 Last night I planned out my driving down to Hilton Head in my head what tools to bring. My plan was to try & slow the leak and install a seepreter system Solar panels charge controller Batterys & pumps

Around 9 am I called Peter Maddock, Peter answered. He told me He was getting caught up and was going to go see

the boys at Palmetto
Bay Marina. I should
have you out next week.
He told me if Clay is
leaving I will check your
boat everyday. That was
great to hear. I am back
to praying and working here
to do all I can.

6/16 Sunday 9:45 pm

This waiting game is
killing me. Now that Clay
is gone, the boat being a
thousand miles away or
a mooring leaking. I am
praying for the phone call
that she is hauled out,
times like this make one
feel quite powerless. On
the other hand I am
so happy to know that
Peter is on it. Thank
God I'm really busy right
now it helps to keep my
mind off tideswinds.

I texted Peter!!!

Weds June 19th

I need to update - on
Monday morning Peter called
he told me things were lined
up to pull the boat out hopefully
by the end of the week. He
said he didn't call because he
had no news. I told him I
get nervous, I used to be
able to text Clay but now
he is on his way to the Keys.
Peter said he checks the lot of Steve
Miller. Don't worry Peter told me
with Clay gone I will keep
an eye on the boat, the hardest
part is lining up the guy who
drives the crane. We need
the crane to pull that 50'
mast out.

After the call I felt so
much better. I can feel
it's happening

It's never really over till it's
over but I feel more
confident now.

6/28/19

this morning I got a call from Jido. He told me the boat was floating fine. I caught him up on all that's transpired over the last few months. Jido asked me if I was able to get a clear title for the Tradewinds I told him that John Cooper had gotten it done.

Jido said he would keep an eye on the boat that he was on the river working on his own boat,

Double relief

Fri 6/28 6am I'm sitting at the Black dog there is an old train car outside the window - Last night around 7:30pm I got a text from Peter Maddock He said "Your boat is out of the water It's not on the trailer yet But it's been hauled out".

Sat 6/29 West Chop Overlook

I worked all day on the little dipper. Little dipper is an 18' Cat boat. I've been picking away at cleaning oiling the teak and getting her in order. She is ready to go into the water any time.

I talked to my Sister Patty on the phone. She said you must be so relieved that you got your boat out of the water. I told her when I got the text from Peter that the boat had been hauled I was over joyed. Peter Maddock made it happen without him I don't even want to think of the jam I would be in. I need to do something to recognise how grateful I am for his help. I remember talking to him quite some time ago. Saying I just can't

seem to get a break with Tradewinds. Because its leaking & held together with band aids out on the mooring I cant take it any distance. Because the starter is all messed up and the fuel in the tank is bad I have no way to move the boat. Peter said I'm going to help you if gonna get you going in the right direction - true to his word. He got it done.

I got a text from [REDACTED]. Steven said he stopped by Palmetto Bay Marina and talked to Peter. Peter said it would be a week or so before the boat was ready for transport to his place.

Sunday June 30, 19

I have gone from bittin my

fingernails off to excitement I know I should be prepared for a shock when I get a professional survey done. I'm in over my head and I know it. Now that tradewinds is out of the water its time to plan the future.

I am suprized at the fact that I have no history on Tradewinds. During the quest for a clear title I found every set of numbers I found the #'s carved into the Hull or behind the steps must have been put there by the original builder, I am curious. I want to know who had it built and where. Who the previous owners were. Really suprized the boat has no history.

For now we wait for the boat to be safely transported to [REDACTED] lot

next I'm going to drive
the dump truck down to
South Carolina. Get all
my stuff out of storage
remove everything off of
Tradewinds that will be
in the way. Demo all
the rot around the center
board & trunk. I want to
leave the boat clean &
ready for survey to be
done --

Monday June 1st

I talked to Peter
Maddock this morning. He said
How are you doing? I said great
I think I got an extra 4 hours
of sleep knowing that Tradewind
is on dry land. Peter said
since we have use of the
travel lift do we want to
take out the centerboard
once its on the trailer and
ready to transport you won't
be able to get it out. I
said that would really

be a smart move. OK he
said I'm on it. I mailed
out a check to Peter for \$2000.00
7/2

I texted Tracy to let him
know the Boat was out of
the river - I also typed Trent.

7/11 7:30 am I got a call
from Tido. Tido told me
the masts had been pulled
and the boat was on the
trailer. He told me that
the Hull looks great - looks
like it just needs new
paint

at 9am I got a text from
Peter Maddock and a picture
tires can't handle the weight
getting 4 tires & rims

I called Peter - Peter told
me that the tires & rims
were just automotive Radials
no way could they take
the weight of Tradewinds

Don't want to lose her half way across the island He said. I told him that I was glad he was going to do it proper & safely. "No one including the boat is going to get hurt" Also he said I'm going to the Sheriff dept. The boat is over 14" wide I want a police escort. Last week they stopped a boat turned them around and made them return to the boatyard.

7/13 7:30 am at Greenwood ave. begining the work day. I texted Peter Maddock that I felt bad about the Coroplats. He called me a little while latter, I said I feel bad about the tires. He said that the tires & rims were on the way. He also told me that he was applying for a Wide load Permit from the S.C. D.O.T. Its just

another hurdle we will get through it. I mailed out a check for \$2000.00 to Peter at 4pm [REDACTED] 5AM texted me a picture tradewinds on the trailer He said "I'm standing next to your boat the masts are out".

7/15 Yesterday I got a text from Tracy - He said now that the Boat is out of the water can we finish our deal. That set me back. I texted him back that tradewinds is still not moved also I asked him to send me his address where I could send him a letter. He texted his E-mail address.

Fri 7/26/19 around six pm I looked at my phone. There was a text from Steven Miller. He said your boat is now at my lot Congrats

I texted back Holly Shit!

~~He~~ texted back that this weekend he was going to jack the trailer up, put blocks under and get the weight off the wheels.

He asked me what my Plans were. I told him that I was going to come down clean the boat out. Cut out all the rot out and try and leave it in a situation where the repairs to the Centerboard Trunk could begin

~~██████████~~ told me that the boat was sitting in a place where it has easy access to electricity & running water

Again I looked at my phone. I had three messages from Peter Maddock. The boat is delivered you on [REDACTED] dock now.

I texted Peter back. Thanking him, You did it I said Peter said I told you I would. I didn't think it would be so difficult!

Peter said he would put together a bill

On Sat morning I called
SAM I asked him
how things were going. He
told how things went when
Peter arrived with the boat

when they were disconnecting
from Peters truck. I said
well thank God it happened
there at the end of the
move and not out on
