A quick note on printing: there's no need to churn through reams of paper. The only pages you have to print are the ones with your confirmation number and luggage tags.

Let me put my stamp here on the passport requirements. All passengers must have a valid U.S. Passport at least six months after their return date. An essential detail - make sure your first and last names match your passport and cruise documents.

On the day you set sail, try to be punctual and arrive at the port near your assigned boarding time. The "all aboard" call will ring 90 minutes before the captain pulls the anchor.

While at the vibrant ports, I suggest you use cash or credit cards. There are better ideas than using debit cards. Yes, MSC will temporarily hold your credit card on the day of departure, and this will fall off shortly after your cruise ends, provided you make no additional purchases onboard the ship.

Keep an eye on the local times when visiting the various ports. Ensure you return to the ship at least 30 minutes before departure. The ship is on a tight sea schedule, and I hate to sail without you!

On a parting note, let me gently remind you to keep your passport, crucial medication, and other important documents close at hand, not tucked away in your checked luggage, during the boarding process.
