However, I strongly recommend that your passports be valid for at least six months beyond your travel dates, as this could change before your travel dates. As part of your travel preparations, please note that travelers must complete an Electronic Immigration form online within 3 days of travel to Saint Lucia. This convenient online process is designed to make your journey easier. If you encounter any difficulties, a paper version can be completed and submitted on-site at the airport upon arrival in St. Lucia; however, I recommend doing this in advance. Please note this process is completed no more than 3 days before your travel using the official website: <https://travelslu.govt.lc/>.
