Now, a few important reminders as you prepare for your voyage:

- Make sure your passport is valid for six months after your return and that the names on your tickets match your passport exactly.
- On boarding day, aim to arrive as close to your assigned boarding time as possible to avoid delays at the port. However, be sure you're onboard at least 90 minutes before the ship's departure.
- At each port, check the "all aboard" time and make sure you're back on the ship before then. Adjust your phone and watch it at the local time. We want the ship to leave with you!
- We recommend using a valid credit card for purchases while traveling internationally. Debit cards are not advised.
- Check with your bank or an airport currency exchange if you need local currency. Let me know if you have any questions!
- Most suites and staterooms will be available after 1:30 p.m. on boarding day, so you may want to pack your swimsuit in your carry-on to enjoy the pool deck.
- Never pack your passport, important documents, or medications in your checked luggage. Keep them with you.
