As of today, all visitors must complete the Dominican Republic Electronic Ticket due to updated health information guidelines. This form is a requisite for entry and must be completed 72 hours before travel. Please make your way to the following site to complete this step: <https://eticket.migracion.gob.do/>

Additionally, ensure your passports are valid for at least six months beyond your planned return date, and please double-check to see that the name matches up with your airline and resort booking confirmations exactly.

Using credit cards is usually advantageous abroad—they offer a layer of fraud protection and often net you more favorable exchange rates than cash or debit cards. They also cut down the need to carry large amounts of currency. However, it's wise to have a modest amount of cash for places not accepting cards or to show appreciation for good service. I do not recommend using debit cards while traveling outside of the U.S.

Always keep your travel documents accessible during your journey. They contain vital contact information, including a 24-hour phone number for assistance should you need it.
