Maria took pride in sewing her own wedding dress. The ceremony commenced with






A Welcome to Country is a ceremony performed by a local
Aboriginal person of significance (usually an Elder) to acknowledge
and give consent to events taking place on their traditional lands. It
is also a sign of respect and protocol which dates back to
traditional times prior to colonisation.

The reception was a mix of traditional Samoan song and dance intertwined with typical Anglo-Indian music, grand march and speeches. An occasion to remember fondly.
