

At the Collins Connect Annual Reunion 2019, the family tree was on display for all attending members to fill-in-the-gaps. The excitement of seeing their family lineage was priceless and worth the effort made at the growing tree. Tracing the family tree beyond the Patriarch Paul Collins is an ongoing task.



The family tree project has been managed by our resident founding member Karen Collins together with collaborator Corrine Collins to achieve the task thus far. Many long hours scanning the ancestry websites researching for the connections has been a tedious but rewarding task.

**This is where we need your help!** Providing key names/pet names or surnames will assist with leads to find the missing linkages. Calling on Alexander Collins family lineage.... Was Alexander known as James Alexander Collins or Alexander James Collins?

Father Henry (Joe) Collins and Mother Cecilia Daly's first born was 'Alexander' Collins. Many ancestry websites identify James Alexander who married Adelaide Watkins. These names have been mentioned by many family members, however the connections to Henry (Joe) Collins is not validated and appears to be a disconnect.



James Alexander Collins' father is identified as *Lazarus* Collins. The children of James Alexander and Adelaide Watkins include Etta Ann Collins, Edgar Paul Collins, Walter Alexander Collins and Irene Nora Ann Collins are names frequently heard but does anyone know the connection?

#### CONGRATULATIONS to Lloyd and Lynette Collins


