TGCA Rules for TGCA In Hand and Ridden Classes

Pure Bred classes are qualifiers for the Best of Breed Finals at the Traditional Gypsy Cob Association's (TGCA) National Breed Championship Show "TOYS". Classes are open to all pure bred traditional gypsy cobs.

Part Bred classes, are open to all part bred traditional gypsy cobs and are qualifiers for the Part Bred Finals at "TOYS". The exhibit **MUST** have one parent that is pure bred traditional gypsy cob, a minimum of 50% breeding is accepted.

Stallions – All stallions (pure or part bred, four years and over) in order to enter any TGCA affiliated class MUST have be TGCA registered, have passed TGCA evaluations and their TGCA stallion disc displayed on their bridle. Stallions and colts over the age of two, **MUST** be shown in a stallion bridle with a metal bit and chain lead as per the current TGCA rulebook.

Existing TGCA members must present their qualification card to the judge in the ring for signature. Non-members will receive a qualification card from the judge and have 21 days to join the TGCA and register their horse to validate the qualification. Please refer to www.tgca.co.uk for further details including membership, horse registration and showing rules (contained within the members handbook).

Quest for a Star Championships Youngstock, In Hand and Ridden

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA classes may go forward to the Quest for a Star Championship, provided they are current TGCA members and the horse is TGCA registered. Membership cards and qualification cards (specific to that exhibit) must be presented upon entry into the ring. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Ultimate Star Championships at TOYS.

Go for Glory Championship In hand and Ridden

1st, 2nd and 3rd from the TGCA part bred classes may go forward to the Go for Glory Championship. For 2021 TOYS qualifiers, the handler/rider and exhibits (apart from stallions) do not have to be TGCA members/registered on the date of the show. The Champion and Reserve qualify for the Crowning Glory Championships at TOYS.

The Greatest Gelding Award - Traditional Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Traditional Gelding.

The judge will award this within the classes/championship

The Greatest Gelding Award - Part Bred Gypsy Cobs

The award is aimed to encourage the showing of geldings, therefore creating a market for often unwanted colt foals and enabling the creation of a network of potential performance prospects to represent the best Part Bred Traditional Gypsy Cob breed in the World at the highest level.

This Award should be given to the highest placed registered Part Bred Traditional Gelding.

TRADITIONAL GYPSY COB RIDDEN

Classes 3 - 5 may be split if into height sections of not to exc 148 cm and 148 cm and above if entries permit. Qualification is split into heights in classes 3 - 9.

- **C3**) Stallions, open to any height
- C4) Mares, open to any height
- C5) Geldings, open to any height
- **C6)** Solid coloured, open to any height or sex
- **C7)** Coloured, including any other colour, open to any height or sex
- **C8)** Junior ridden. Rider 18 years and under, open to any height or sex. Lead rein included.
- **C9)** Novice or green cob, exhibits not to have been 1st in any affiliated class, prior to Jan 1st in the current year. Open to any height or sex

OPEN RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to first and second from classes C3 to C9. Open to non members and TGCA members.

Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme Ridden.

QUEST FOR A STAR RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the top three from classes C3 to C9. **Open to TGCA members** with registered cobs. Membership cards **must** be presented. Champion and Reserve go forward to the Ultimate Star Ridden Championship at TOYS.

Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme Ridden.

SUPREME RIDDEN OF SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to Champion and Reserve from the Open Ridden and Quest Ridden Championships.

TGCA Membership voucher to Supreme Champion, valid 2018 or 2019 membership.

- C10) Young stock Open to yearlings, any sex, any height
- C11) 2 & 3 yr olds any sex, any height

Open to top three from classes C10 and C11. Open to non members and TGCA members.

PART BRED YOUNGSTOCK GO FOR GLORY CHAMPIONSHIP

IN HAND PART BRED TRADITIONAL GYPSY COBS

- C12) In Hand Senior four years plus, any sex, under 148 cm
- C13) In Hand Senior four years plus, any sex, 148 cm and over

PART BRED IN HAND GO FOR GLORY CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to top three from classes C12 and C13. Open to non members and TGCA members.

Champion and Reserve go Forward to Supreme of Show Part Bred

SUPREME PART BRED OF SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to Champion and Reserve from Go for Glory Young stock, In Hand and Ridden Championships. **TGCA Membership voucher to Supreme Champion, valid 2021 or 2022 membership.**

- C15) 2 year old any sex or height

YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to top two from classes C14 to C18. Open to non members and TGCA members.

Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme In Hand.

QUEST FOR A STAR YOUNGSTOCK CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the top three from classes C14 to C18. **Open to TGCA members** with registered cobs. Membership cards **must** be presented. Champion and Reserve go forward to the Ultimate Star Youngstock Championship at TOYS. *Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme In Hand.*

IN HAND TRADITIONAL GYPSY COBS

Classes C19 – C 21 may be split if into height sections of not to exc 148 cm and 148 cm and above if entries permit. Qualification is split into heights in classes C19 – C23. Entries to be four years and over.

- C19) Stallion In Hand
- C20) Mare In Hand
- C21) Gelding In Hand
- C22) In Hand Coloured
- C23) In Hand Solid Coloured

SENIOR IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to first and second from classes C19 to C23. Open to non members and TGCA members.

Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme In Hand.

QUEST FOR A STAR IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the top three from classes C19 to C23. **Open to TGCA members** with registered cobs. Membership cards **must** be presented. Champion and Reserve go forward to the Ultimate Star Youngstock or Senior In Hand Championship at TOYS.

Champion and Reserve go forward to Supreme In Hand.

SUPREME IN HAND OF SHOW CHAMPIONSHIP

SHOWGROUND

- Stables/bedding to be booked directly with Andrea Briggs at TGCA Head Office.
- Members and competitors must comply with all the showground rules.

- Classes may be split into sections if entries warrant.
