Stake Single Adult Representatives

- Who are Stake Single Adult Reps The Stake Presidency can assign any of the following individuals to be Stake Single Adult Reps: Stake Presidency, High Councilman, Stake Relief Society, Singles, Married or anyone that the Stake would like The WCSA Committee to be in contact with.
- **Contact Information** Be sure that we have your updated contact information from all your Stake Reps by emailing Idssinglesstg@gmail.com
- Stake Assignments Mainly Firesides, Dances, Single Conferences, and other duties as assigned. Details can be found in the "Instructions for Assignments" section. The schedule is distributed once it has been approved. A member of the WCSA committee will be contacting you weeks before your assigned activity.
- WCSA Regional Leadership Meetings These meetings give us the opportunity to: Discuss changes in the Single Adult Program, Coordinate assignments, Counsel together, and answer any questions you may have. We typically have 4 Leadership meetings a year. We encourage your Stake Single Adult Reps to join. If you are not able to attend, we ask that you send a representative in your place. Anyone is welcome to join our WCSA Monthly Regional Committee Meeting. Just let us know and we will give you the details of our upcoming meeting.
- Stakes Hosting Regional Activities If your stake wants to host an activity for the entire region, please email Idssinglesstg@gmail.com by the 20th of the month (Description, Date, Time, Location and Details). We can also distribute a flyer if you have one. This gives us time to get the event posted to the calendar, create the flyer, and distribute it to the stakes by the 1st of the month.

Ward Single Adult Representatives

- Who are the Ward Single Adult Reps The Bishop can assign any of individuals (married or single) to be Ward Single Adult Reps.
- **Assignments** Minister to the singles in their ward, distribute information from the stake to their ward singles and assist Stake Reps with any assignments.

Please remember that singles are best served on a ward or stake level. Single adult representation at the ward level is the most effective and rewarding way to activate and involve single adult members.

Suggestions for Ministering to Single Adults in your Ward and Stake

"The Savior invites all to come unto Him and belong to His Church. Men and women who have not yet married or who are divorced or widowed make up a significant portion of Church membership. It is important for all to find hope through the Atonement of Jesus Christ." (General Handbook 14) The Lord has asked us to love one another and minister to those in need. "Ministering means serving others as the Savior did. He loved, taught, prayed for, comforted, and blessed those around Him. As disciples of Jesus Christ, we seek to minister to God's children." (General Handbook 21.0) Please seek out ways to **ENGAGE** with the singles you have stewardship over. Here are a few suggestions that might be helpful.

- Refer to the "General Handbook Section 14. Single Members" for guidance. "This handbook will help you to learn principles of Christlike service and understand your responsibilities. You will be most effective when you align your service in the Church with the work of God the Father and His Son, Jesus Christ." (General Handbook 1.0)
- Setup a networking group in your stake. Calling Ward Reps or Sheparding Couples to minister to the singles in your stake.
- Including singles at church socials and other events.
- Expand lesson topics that are specific to marriage.
- Be inclusive when making ward temple plans.
- Unify the singles by organizing and hosting Ward or Stake Single Activities.
- Have the single activities announced in Relief Society and Priesthood meetings with prior approval by the bishop.
- Organize a carpool for activities.
- You might volunteer to take and pick up elderly singles.
- Make sure they have been assigned ward members to minister to them.
- Find ways for them to be involved in the stakes and wards.
- Share with them information about the Single Adult Program.
- Have the WCSA website posted in the ward bulletin. www.washsa.com
- Discuss the needs of the singles in your correlation meetings.
- Display the Single Adult Poster on your Ward and Stake bulletin boards.
- Invite the singles to help with the regional assignments.
- Set-up a Stake Single Adult email group and email all the singles in your stake the activity information.
- Try and not make the singles feel different just because they are single, simply treat them as a Child of God.
- If you know singles in your stake that would benefit from being part of the WCSA Committee let us know. We are always looking for singles to help with activities. An excellent way to get involved, serve others, and create lasting friendships.

Instructions for Assignments - Hosting Firesides

Firesides are held mostly on Sundays from 700pm-830pm. They consist of speakers, music, prayers, and refreshments.

Building – Reserve a building including chapel, kitchen, and cultural hall. The choir usually practices before the firesides so please have the chapel accessible at 530pm.

Speakers – Speakers must be pre-approved by your Stake Presidency. You may want to secure speakers well in advance, including any technical assistance they need. Please ask speakers to take no longer than 35 minutes to allow ample mingle time. Many singles expressed a desire to hear the perspective of other singles.

Leadership – Please invite your Stake Presidency, High Councilman, Stake Single Adult Reps, and spouses to attend the fireside.

Conducting – Single Adult Reps, High Councilman or Stake Presidency may conduct the meeting. Whomever you prefer. Please announce the upcoming activities that can be found on the Monthly Flyer. Also remind the audience to silence their phones.

Greeters – Please have greeters at each door welcoming the singles to the fireside. If possible, please print out the flyer and other information to hand out to the singles.

Setup – Please provide people to help with setting up the speaker and the refreshments. Later that evening you will need to help cleaning up.

Prayers – Please provide an opening and closing prayer. Asking singles from the audience is just fine; you might want to ask them before the meeting starts.

Refreshments – Please provide refreshments and paper goods for 125-150 people. Set up for singles to mingle is strongly encouraged.

Music – Please provide an opening and closing song, including pianist and chorister. You may also provide your own special musical number. If you want the Single Adult Choir to sing, reach out to the choir conductor 2 weeks in advance. (Valorie Myers • 770-845-3527 • Yourarmygal@yahoo.com)

Follow-up – A member of the WCSA Committee will be contacting you approximately 8 weeks before the activity to get the details of the Fireside posted on the calendar, included in the Flyer and other promotional tools. (Location, Speaker, Topic)

Ministering – Firesides are a great opportunity for you to minister to the singles in your stake as well as the region. Ask the singles to participate in hosting the fireside. (Greeters, Setting Up, Prayers, Music, Refreshments, Cleaning up ...)
