Daily Recap: Thursday Friday - Dario arrived late night Wednesday, then was delayed at immigration for 2.5 hours. Last evening, after Dennis taught on faith, Pastor Dario led four new young men into the Kingdom. The previous night, we saw many healing miracles; after praying for six people's ailments, two more were healed spontaneously. What a special move of the Holy Spirit. The enemy attacked four members of the team with GI issues, yet all the meetings continued because of the saints' prayers.

Saturday and Sunday—Each believer received a fresh outpouring from the Holy Spirit. On both days, two pastor couples and their families came in support with music and prayers. We may be experiencing the birth of a church, like the ones in the Book of Acts. Gracious Dios.

Monday was a slower day, and we were able to visit the boss of a member who needed healing for his son. On Tuesday, we made a 300AM departure to visit the Tlalocan ruins, and we had an exciting balloon ride over the pyramids while praying over the nation. We returned from our 11-hour excursion in time to eat and share the vision for this church with two pastoral couples. Everyone shared their hearts and desire to see His Kingdom expand.

Wednesday afternoon, we met with a local pastor who will help Dario get a Mexican work permit and assist the church with the necessary government paperwork to register.

Thursday – We went to Walmart and, in faith, purchased an outside pool for baptism. Many new believers are reluctant to become water-baptized because of previous false doctrines. We had some extra time, so we took a quick trip to the city square, seeing some Aztec ruins, and then to the Museum of Natural History. That evening, we visited the Jose family, offering prayers and encouragement.

Friday - Water baptism message to 18 people, with four deciding to follow Jesus' example and command to get water baptized. WOW! Pastor Dario said this was a miracle, and everyone was very excited for Saturday's baptisms.

Saturday - Six Water Baptism and Pastor Dario released pastoral couples to lead this new church plant. (Enrique Rod and Ely Vilchis) Finished service with ~8 people getting healed from pains and illnesses. They each touched their area of pain as Dario proclaimed Christ's blood victory.
