- -We are still looking for another show facility with enough stalls available for our typical number of horses.
- -We need 50-60 rides per show to break even

- -It was suggested that we should look into advertising on FB. There are many groups which are suitable. (Florida horse events, Manasota Horse club, Florida Horse and Tack)
- -The Bill Woods Clinic was very nice and everybody who participated was learning a lot, but all the spots were not filled.
- -The June meeting will be at the Fruitville library
- -The date for the banquet will probably late October, early November
- -The clinic this fall is not confirmed yet. *Update:* Kelly Layne will come in November, so that is something exciting to look forward to!!!! Details to follow soon.

## Status Update of USEF Freestyle Rule DR 129 May 9, 2019

Regarding USEF freestyle rule DR 129 which went into effect on December 1, 2018:

During the USEF Board of Directors (BOD) meeting, held April 29, 2019, the USEF BOD reviewed the feedback received and discussed the Extraordinary Rule Change Proposal (Tracking ID# 022-19), regarding DR129. As a result of the discussion, the USEF BOD "felt it was in the best interest of the sport to disapprove the RCP as presented," as stated in the letter from USEF to the affiliate leadership.

The USEF Dressage Sport Committee has submitted an alternative rule change proposal that is currently going through the USEF rule change process. Once this rule change proposal has been certified by the USEF Legislative Committee, it will be available for comment. If certified as an Extraordinary Rule Change, it will be presented to the USEF BOD at their mid-year meeting. The current USEF Rule DR129 remains in effect.

The current rule can be found in the USEF Rule Book on the USEF website, along with the active rule changes and those recently approved by the USEF BOD.

## New for 2020: USDF Announces Regional Schooling Show Awards Program

Lexington, KY (February 22, 2019) - The United States Dressage Federation™ (USDF) is excited to announce the new USDF Regional Schooling Show Awards Program, which will offer regional recognition to USDF Group Members (GMs), competing in participating non-USEF-licensed/non-USDF-recognized competitions. This program will operate congruently with the annual USDF membership year of December 1 - November 30, beginning with the 2020 membership year on December 1, 2019. Four award divisions, including open, junior/young rider, adult amateur, and non-professional, will be recognized per region. The open division will offer six levels of recognition (Training, First, Second, Third, Fourth, and FEI), with the junior/young rider, adult amateur, and non-professional offering an additional seventh level (Introductory).

Any non-USEF-licensed/non-USDF-recognized competition is eligible to participate, and may do so by simply submitting an online application and fee to USDF, at least 30 days prior to the start date of their competition. Competitors wishing to participate in the program must be USDF Group Members and submit an online nomination application and fee for each horse/rider combination they wish to nominate.

USDF President Lisa Gorretta explains that, "this new program has been developed to recognize the achievements of USDF Group Members, who choose to participate in schooling shows as their competition path. It will give competitors confirmation of how they stack up against their peers, within their USDF region. This will, in turn, strengthen USDF's Group Member Organizations by providing an additional exclusive benefit of membership! Schooling shows provide and promote dressage education for riders, USDF L Graduates, and licensed judges, as well as local competition management and show volunteers. We hope to welcome more members and competitors into the USDF community, while furthering USDF's mission of recognizing achievement in dressage."

Both competition management and competitors will be able to begin signing up to participate in the program, beginning in July 2019.
