Costume Class Information – Plan ahead!

For our Halloween show on November 1st we will be offering two types of fun classes; a costume class either mounted or unmounted, and a "free-for-all" musical freestyle class, which will be offered in addition to the regular USDF freestyle class. **There will be prizes!** These classes will be run in conjunction with the lunch break.

Class 81: Creepy Costume Class

Mounted or unmounted, individual or teams but must include at least one horse. Judged Parade style.

Any movement, any level, any music, any combination of movements, any number of riders.

Must include a halt at beginning and end. May not be longer than 5 minutes. Judged as per a regular freestyle but without any required or restricted movements.
