


#### **Event Roundup**

Book Review – Freestyle

<u>Freestyle</u> by Sandra Beaulieu Published 2020, Trafalgar Square \$34.95

Whether you are a person who wants to design your own freestyle or a person who chooses a professional design, this book is equally helpful. Sandra Beaulieu clearly explains freestyle from conception to competition and offers lots of tips and encouraging interviews from other freestyle enthusiasts along the way.

There are 3 parts to this book. In the first part, the author begins by defining terminology and the scored competition elements of a freestyle. She then moves right into the heart of a freestyle: how to choose the right music for you and your horse.

Part 2 of the book focuses on choreography of the competition freestyle. There are over 100 pages of movements and diagrams in this section divided between Dressage and Western Dressage. An explanation of each movement includes the test level (from basic through upper level) and requirements of use. The author includes strategies to play to the strengths of the horse or

change the difficulty of a movement for higher freestyle scores. Beaulieu finishes this section with discussion of how to put your choreography and music together. She discusses basic music editing, timing, software options and how to perfect the finished product.

Part 3 of this book is dedicated to Exhibition Freestyles which is produced in a similar manner to competition freestyles but with additions such as tricks, props, costuming, make-up, riding with multiple horses and performing in various venues.

Sandra Beaulieu is a very encouraging author with a clear passion to help riders experience the joy of freestyle. This book is well organized and heavily illustrated. The "success" stories incorporated throughout the book are interesting and do not interrupt the flow of information.
