Parent & Guardian FAQ Companion

We understand that international travel—especially involving service and homestays—is a big decision for families. This FAQ is designed to provide clarity, transparency, and peace of mind as you consider whether this expedition is the right fit for your child.

What is the Global Impact Expedition?

The Global Impact Expedition is a transformational travel experience for youth ages 12–17 focused on:

- Ethical service learning
- Cultural immersion
- Leadership development
- Homestay experiences with vetted local families

Participants engage in hands-on projects, reflective learning, and guided mentorship while traveling responsibly and respectfully.

Who is this program designed for?

This expedition is best suited for students who:

- Are curious, open-minded, and willing to learn
- Are interested in service, leadership, and global awareness
- Can adapt to new environments and group settings
- Are ready for personal growth beyond traditional travel

No prior international travel experience is required. Passport is required.

How are students selected?

Due to limited availability, participation is application-based. Selection considers:

- Student readiness and maturity
- Alignment with program values
- Commitment to learning and service
- Completed application materials

Not all applicants will be accepted.

What safety measures are in place?

Student safety is our highest priority. We provide:

- Experienced adult leaders traveling with the group
- Trusted, vetted local partners and homestay families
- Clear safety protocols and emergency plans
- On-site coordination throughout the expedition
- Pre-departure orientation for students and families

We also maintain communication with families before, during, and after travel.

What is a homestay experience like?

Homestays are a cornerstone of cultural learning. Students:

- Stay with vetted local families
- Experience daily life, traditions, and meals
- Are supported by staff and local coordinators
- Are never placed alone—students stay in pairs or small groups

Homestays are selected with safety, respect, and cultural exchange in mind.

What kind of service projects will students participate in?

Service projects are community-led and ethically designed, ensuring:

- Projects meet real, identified community needs

- Local voices guide the work
- Students learn with communities, not for them
- Emphasis on dignity, collaboration, and sustainability

Examples may include education support, clean water initiatives, or environmental projects.

How does this differ from a typical student trip?

This is not tourism.

Unlike traditional trips, this expedition emphasizes:

- Ethical engagement over sightseeing
- Reflection and leadership development
- Long-term community partnerships
- Cultural humility and responsibility

Students return with deeper perspective, confidence, and purpose.

What is expected of families?

Families are expected to:

- Support the application and preparation process
