- •To slow your mind, slow your breathing down. The deeper you breathe the calmer you will get.
- Progress is to slow to be noticed and setbacks happen so fast.
- •For many of us the great danger is not that we will renounce our faith. It is that we will become so distracted and rushed and preoccupied that we will settle for a mediocre version of it.
- •Hurry is violence on the human soul. Slow down.
- •Both the snail and the turtle made it on the ark.
- •Don't ever measure what you can do based on someone else.
- •God is good even when times are not.

- •Stop rebuking all the stress in your life. Maybe God is growing you.
- Every crisis that comes in your life brings an opportunity for something. Find the opportunity.
- •When you finally learn that a persons behavior has more to do with their own struggle than you, you learn grace.

- Nothing good grows in the comfort zone except mediocrity
- •God doesn't always remove suffering from our lives when we want him to, but He always transforms us through it when we trust Him.
- •God gives you a sufficiency of grace.
- •Contentment is a mindset, an attitude.
- •Philippians 4:11-13 "Not that I was ever in need, for I have learned how to be content with whatever I have. I know how to live on almost nothing or with everything. I have learned the secret of living in every situation, whether it is with a full stomach or empty, with plenty or little. For I can do everything through Christ, who gives me strength."
- •Contentment is not a gift it's a lesson.
- •You don't just try to be content you have to train to be content.
- •Whatever you want to do in life you have to train for it.
- •You don't just try for stuff you train for it.
- •Train your emotions to keep yourself tempered.
- •Philippians 1:12-14, 29-30 "And I want you to know, my dear brothers and sisters, that everything that has happened to me here has helped to spread the Good News. For everyone here, including the whole palace guard, knows that I am in chains because of Christ. And because of my imprisonment, most of

the believers here have gained confidence and boldly speak God's message without fear. For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the privilege of suffering for him. We are in this struggle together. You have seen my struggle in the past, and you know that I am still in the midst of it."

- •The moment that you are in does not pause the mission you are on.
- •The secret of joy is Christ in You not you in another circumstance.
- •Gods plans for your life far exceed the circumstances of your day.
- •Oftentimes, God will isolate you to draw you to himself so you can discover your true identity and purpose.
- •We need Gods perspective to understand Gods ways and purpose:
- •Your purpose originates from above not below.
- •Your purpose comes alive through serving not self promotion
- •Your purpose is powered by your obedience not your autonomy
- Your purpose unfolds over decades not days
- Your purpose is shaped by Gods Grace not your goofs
- Praise is the pinnacle of your purpose not productivity.
- •God never said the journey would be easy, but he did say the arrival would be worth while.
- •One of the devils most effective tools is distraction.
- •If he Distracts you with battles he keeps your eyes off the breakthrough.
- •If he distracts you with Burden can't see blessing
- •If he distracts you with Fear can't see freedom
- •If he distracts you with Hindrances can't see health
- •If he distracts you with What you lack what you have left
- •If he distracts you with Pain you can't see purpose
- •If he distracts you with Problems can't see possibilities
- •If he distracts you with Trouble can't see triumphs
- •If he distracts you with Weakness can't see winning.
- •Don't ask why is this happening to me, instead ask what is this trying to teach me?
- •Psalm 103:7MEV "He made known His ways to Moses, His acts to the people of Israel."
- •Proverbs 19:21GNT "People may plan all kinds of things, but the Lord's will is going to be done."

- •Peace is always based on perspective
- Daniel slept in the lions den.
- Peter slept in prison
- •Jesus slept on the stormy boat
- •Miracles often begin with the ordinary.
- •Great things are not done by impulse, but by a series of small things brought together.
- •God doesn't just do good he is good
- •Good is who God is and what he does
- •Exodus 33:19 "The Lord replied, "I will make all my goodness pass before you, and I will call out my name, Yahweh, before you. For I will show mercy to anyone I choose, and I will show compassion to anyone I choose."
- •You cannot heal what you cannot feel.
- •Compassion is love with a direction
- •The best use of life is love. The best expression of love is time. The best time to love is now.
- •Who is blocking you from seeing Jesus. Who do you need to get over so you can see Jesus.
- Regardless of what has happened in your life it will take time for God to unveil the purpose.
- •Sometimes God will let you walk through the fire so that the demons can be shaken off in the place they belong and you come out of it loosed. When you walk with God, what has killed other people will loose you to Gods purpose.
