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- •It was God himself who established boundaries
- •When earth was created it was without form and void. God gave it boundaries.
- •Boundaries give us form.
- •God made a distinction between heaven and earth, between night and day, between dry land and water.
- •There are some problems God will place in your life that are designed to be a God sized problem.
- •A Lot means an assignment.
- •When you inherit something, that comes with responsibility. It's an inheritance but it's also an assignment.
- When God gives you a lot he says this is your responsibility.
- •Blessings come with boundaries
- Positions come with boundaries
- Property come with boundaries
- Money come with boundaries
- Our Personhood come with boundaries
- Freedom come with boundaries
- •Wars are fight and lives are lost when we do not respect boundaries
- Marriages are destroyed and trust is broken when we don't respect boundaries
- Health is destroyed when we don't respect boundaries
- •Sleep depravity is experienced when we don't respect the boundary of going to bed on time
- •Boundaries keep babies from falling down steps and from getting into cabinets to consume something poisonous
- Proverbs 21:23 "Watch your tongue and keep your mouth shut, and you will stay out of trouble."
- •Boundaries are not punishment; boundaries are protection
- •Just because you CAN do something doesn't mean you SHOULD
- •Boundaries create clarity; clarity gives focus; focus produces power!
- •You are multi gifted but there is 1 gift that is your moneymaker. Flow in your gift. Flow in your power. You can go further.
- •If you lack focus you lack power.
- •You cannot speed up Gods process for your life but your disobedience can slow it down.
- •Create some rules for yourself.
- Decide your limits!
- •We get into addictions when we don't have limits. How much is too much? How far is too far?
- •When you don't set boundaries, You don't even realize what's happening to you until it's too late.
- Sometimes you can sin by doing nothing.
- •James 4:17 "Remember, it is sin to know what you ought to do and then not do it." (Sin of omission)
- Discernment is key.
- •Trust is restricted to whatever is within the boundary of truth! We can only trust what is ultimately based on truth.
- •Not everything that is legal is right
- •Righteousness, peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost are the result of walking within the boundaries of Gods word and his will for your life
- •A boundary is something that shows the end of something and hence the beginning of something different.
- •A limitation is a restriction that does not allow you to proceed.
- •Limitations don't show you how far you can go limitations show you how short you stopped.

- •Some limitations are designed to be broken.
- •When there's a seed in you the seed begins to reproduce and it will break through limitations
- •God is on the rise!
- •Miracles happen, promises come into manifestation when God is on the rise.
- •Some of your change will happen because your mind opens. Other change will happen because your heart is broken.
- •When you break or when your mind opens you are no longer the same person.
- •When God wants to maximize your change he will open your mind and break your heart at the same time.
- •1 Peter 5:8-9 "Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. Stand firm against him, and be strong in your faith. Remember that your family of believers all over the world is going through the same kind of suffering you are."
- •The devil loves for us to fight each other so that we can't fight the real enemy.
- •Sometimes you question your faith because your living with doubt
- •There's doubt in your head and doubt in your heart. The doubt in your head is meant to protect you. God uses some doubts as curiosity and will cause you to ask questions and as you answer those questions it will lead you to faith.
- •Trust God when you can't trace God.
- •One of the greatest disservice we can give to our children is to let them live without the discipline of boundaries.
- •Not all kindness comes off as nice because it can be a confrontation of truth. It's kind because that truth can stop you from an embarrassment.
- •As parents we must give our children boundaries. You need to notice things in them when they are little and you help to restrict them so that they develop in that area.
- •Whatever area you want to build, isolate it. As you focus on that area it will develop and elevate.
- •There is always separation before there is elevation.
- •Your next season comes through something that looks like dormancy.
- •Ask God to give you courage to be kind and do what is right. Ask God to give you discernment to know the timing and the season of the Lord. Ask God to show you the boundaries and the limits to set to take you to the next level. Ask God to show you the glory.
