Round, but not a Ball



- Just a few chapters before this (22:18), Isaiah refers to a 'ball'. Isaiah had the word ball, but did not use it to describe the earth - because it is round, but not a ball.
- Earth's atmosphere, is literally propped up over earth like a tent.
- A footstool is never spherical; it is flat-topped, with supports underneath it.

Not Hanging?

The earth (dirt) is not hanging or suspended over nothingness (space); the Bible makes it clear that there are foundations and pillars supporting the earth. There isn't anything that the world is hanging from - it is set upon.

What is the Firmament?

- The Bible describes the firmament as a physical object that is strong, and like reflective glass; mirror-like.
- It is a dividing barrier between the lower water, and upper water.
- God's Throne is above the firmament.
- "And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it." - Frekia 17-6.
- "Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens."
 Psalm 148:4

- "Hast thou with him spread out the sky, which is strong, and as a molten looking glass?" - Job 37:18
- And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.
