Background setting(s): the geographical location(s)
The Writer or Author: of the book(s) that you are reading/studying.
The Main Idea or An Underlying Meaning of What You're Studying: the theme.
The Month, Year/Time: the date.
Context: gives clarification of a statement or an idea.
Content: gives relationship of the topic.
<u>Cross Reference</u> : a scripture that refer/relates the same or similar interpretation and events that gives deeper understandings.
