Dr. OZ is continuing her important work with Ukrainian National Guard units, working with them both in Kyiv and near the front lines. She had the chance in July to work with an **elite drone unit** near the front. She was also finally able to travel to Israel in mid-July to continue her consulting work with therapists there.



We hope you have already watched the first 3 and enjoy hearing directly from our staff! A new staff video will be posted every Friday.




### Pledge Forms:



This month, it's our Board Treasurer:

Dr. Andreas Bienert

Dr. Andreas Bienert has devoted his professional life to advancing mental health and addiction treatment. A native of Austria, Andreas's path was shaped by the rich psychological legacy of his homeland, famously home to Sigmund Freud. He has nearly two decades of experience as a recognized leader in addiction and trauma across inpatient and outpatient settings. With a deep commitment to holistic and individualized care, Dr. Bienert has worked with children, adolescents, adults, couples, and families, skillfully adapting to a variety of therapeutic environments.

Wanting to integrate cutting-edge research into his practice, he chose to pursue both his master's and doctoral degrees at Regent University in Virginia Beach. This education experience was transformative. In 2013, he joined the very first cohort, led by Dr. Olya Zaporozhets and Dr. Linda Leitch Alford to Ukraine. He jumped at the chance to travel to Ukraine with a small group of students and faculty, contributing to the foundational efforts of the counseling profession in Ukraine by offering basic counseling skills training and cross-cultural practicum supervision. This early initiative laid the groundwork for long-term collaboration and helped establish essential infrastructure for counseling education in the region and helped bring to life what has evolved into two key organizations in global mental health: the International Institute of Postgraduate Education and the Ukrainian Institute of Trauma Therapy (UIT).

Andreas also played a crucial role as a liaison supporting the program's formal recognition by the International Registry of Counselor Education Programs (IRCEP), where he also serves as an Advisory Council Member. Under this expanded structure, the institute now offers not only skills-based training but also advanced, specialized postgraduate programs, including Child & Adolescent Mental Health Counseling, Marriage & Family Counseling, and Trauma Therapy. He views his role on the IRCEP Advisory Council as an opportunity to bridge the gap between academic standards and real-world mental health needs across cultures. Through both his leadership and international collaboration, he continues to shape the future of global mental health education and practice.

Andreas currently serves as Chief Clinical Officer at a leading outpatient addiction treatment facility in Virginia, is responsible for overseeing all clinical services and supervising a multidisciplinary team of clinicians. His leadership ensures the delivery of high-quality, evidence-based care that supports patient recovery and long-term well-being. In addition to his clinical role, Andreas is a counselor educator, dedicated to training emerging mental health professionals with a strong foundation in both research and compassionate practice, as part of his ongoing dedication to elevating counseling education worldwide.

Away from his professional pursuits, Andreas lives in Virginia with his wife, two young children, and their family dog. He enjoys traveling when possible and treasures local adventures with his family. These moments of connection and exploration reflect the same values he brings to his work: empathy, curiosity, and a deep respect for the human experience.

We are so grateful that his journey from Austria to the United States, and from clinician to educator and global mental health advocate, led him to our team!
