### **IMHC UPDATES**



CallSign:Courage is our new program to give Ukrainian men a sense of community and a "tribe" when reaching a hand out to ask for help with their mental health.

For far too long men in Ukraine - military and civilian - have been told to just push it down and keep going. We're changing that one life at a time.

This partnership of IMHC, UIT Charitable Fund and Open Doors is getting men in Ukraine the mental health support they need. Our staff is currently work with about 150 men in Ukraine through in-patient, out-patient and virtual appointments.

IMHC is a Virginia-based non-profit with staff and volunteers around the world. We are excited to use this newsletter to introduce our amazing, dedicated team!

This month, it's our Advisory Team Member:

Dr. Linda Leitch Alford

Dr. Linda Leitch Alford (Dr. LA to her students) is a devoted mental health professional, professor, and supervisor with over 40 years of experience. She is also part of our origin story! In this special Team Spotlight she recounts the journey that she and Dr. OZ took to get us here today.

"I met Olya in the spring of 2012 when she came to Regent to interview for a faculty position. I was coordinator of the PhD program and took her to breakfast one morning where we talked about my heart for Eastern Europe, which started in 1983 when my family traveled to what was then Yugoslavia (now Croatia). When I returned to the USA, I immediately realized I had left a large part of my heart in Eastern Europe.

By early Fall 2012, Olya was in my office sharing that she wanted to start the Ukrainian counseling profession. The notion of starting a program in Ukraine became part of my soul and together we spent the rest of the fall and spring terms planning the program and courses we would teach. Students were recruited from the Regent Masters and PhD programs in Counseling as assistant facilitators. Olya secured arrangements for us to spend two weeks at Tavriski Christian Institute, located in Kherson. Ukrainian students were recruited, we made travel plans, and we were off - realizing our dream.

That first trip to Ukraine was full of adventure, challenges, and learning for the program students as well as Regent teaching assistants (*Including Andreas, whom you met in the Summer e-news last month!*), and faculty. I led the Skills course and enjoyed every minute of the energy both Regent students and Ukrainian students brought to each session. Not all of the Regent students were Americans - they were also Lithuanian, Austrian, Singaporean, and Siberian. This gave us a very full perspective and a wonderful learning environment.

2014 brought the Maidan Revolution of Dignity protest followed by the Russian invasion and annexation of Crimea. Plans were adjusted. We continued our work online, and Olya eventually secured a new space for the program at the Ukrainian Theological Evangelical Seminary (UTES) just outside of Kyiv. In 2015, 2016, and 2018 I was able to again join the program in person. These trips were so rich and I will forever treasure these experiences. Even though my last trip was in 2018, the program has never been out of my mind or heart. Now I have left another part of my heart in a second Eastern European country – Ukraine.

One of my professional specialties is Counseling Ethics. I taught the Ethics course in Ukraine and talked about the reality that no profession is valid until there is a hammered out Ethics Code. The Code we now have is truly a reflection Ukrainian thinking and I am so pleased for the work the committee did to create this very professional and very Ukrainian document



What joy it is to see our efforts from 2013 grow into a graduate school, and a counseling center serving military, children, and community members both face-to-face and virtually. My heart hurts for Ukraine in this wartime yet I am learning to hold the sadness and pain with the embrace of God."

When not dreaming of/actively plotting her return to Ukraine, Dr. LA lives in South Jersey with her husband Tom, and Toffee, a rescue Cavalier King

Charles Spaniel. She loves tending her garden with her daughter Julia, visiting the Jersey shore and weekends in Alexandria with her daughter Carrie Ann, who works for IMHC. Daughter and son-in-law Julia and Keith live just outside of Philly. Please keep Dr. LA and her family in your thoughts and prayers.


