Right of Way Hazardous Fuels Reduction

The Storey County Fire Protection District, in cooperation with the Virginia City Highlands Property Associations, will be removing hazardous fuels from road right-of-ways to help with control of future wildland fires, improve ingress and egress, and reduce the threat to public and firefighter safety.

Heavy accumulations of fuel, dead and dying trees, brush, grasses and weeds will be removed by hand and utilizing a track mounted "Masticator" under the direction of a Forester and Fire District personnel.

Individual property owners, adjacent to or abutting the road right-of-ways being treated may participate in the hazardous fuels reduction project at no cost.

The first phase of the project will begin Wednesday October 14, 20015 on the east side of the Virginia City Highlands, specifically: Dry Lake Road, Overland, Victoria and Rocky Road, then move to the south and complete work on Grande and Livery, before treating the entire length of Cartwright Road and the last half of Lousetown Road.

Additional, detailed, information will be presented at the Virginia City Highlands Property Association meetings on Tuesday October 13th and Tuesday October 27th.
