



**GAP is a one-time assistance per beneficiary per year.**

**Ex: if you are a beneficiary in April and receive assistance in the amount of \$1500 you cannot apply in May of the same year for \$500.**

**Criteria:**

- **Discharge status other than dishonorable.**
- **Income: Previous 3 months at or below the 50% AMI for the county the beneficiary lives in [FY 2025 Income Limits Documentation System](#)**
- **Statement must be in the veterans name. (screenshots are not accepted) Please connect with your local Veterans Service Office in your county to help you submit your application and documents.**
- **The request(s) may not exceed \$2,000.00 TOTAL**
- **If the statement and/or request are over \$2,000 the balance over \$2,000 must be paid first before GAP can pay the \$2,000.**
- **GAP is a first come first serve. All requests are submitted to the committee for review once ALL PROPER documents have been received by the GAP Counselor.**
  - **GAP assistance covers current balance due per qualifying beneficiary. Anything over 90 days past due is not eligible for services.**
  - **GAP assistance will not make advance payments. Ex: prepay future months.**
  - **GAP pays the vendor directly by check through certified mail. Payments will not be made online or over the phone.**
  - **All PDF statements must include the following information to be considered for assistance: (screenshots are not accepted)**
  - **Bill to name and address**
  - **Remit to name and address**
  - **account number**
  - **current amount due.**

**Please complete this intake survey before your schedule appointment**

*If you meet the criteria, please complete the application, gather all documents listed on the application as well as:*

**For each household member:**

- **All employment showing YTD Gross, self-employment or cash (from employment, side jobs, friends/family, etc.)**
- **Child support and/or unemployment income**
- **The previous 3 months bank statement and/or savings statements.**
- **Award letter from VA, BAH (is considered income) and Social Security, if applicable**



*If requesting assistance for:*

- Utilities – Current PDF statements for utility bills **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Rent/Mortgage – Lease agreement signed by all parties and current PDF statement/ledger from landlord or current mortgage statement **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Car Note – Current PDF statement **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Car Insurance – Current PDF statement **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Auto Repairs – Proof of ownership, ex: title or car note or current registration and 3 estimates for repairs (Repair facility must be in Texas) **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Internet – Current PDF statement (GAP does not cover TV/cable bills) **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Cell Phone – Current PDF statement **(screenshots are not accepted)**
- Books/Tuition – Current PDF statements **(screenshots are not accepted)**
