Each year the Southeast Spokane County Fair board selects fair royalty to represent our community at annual local events. The chosen candidates also receive a scholarship. This year, the board is seeking four young girls (1 queen and 3 princesses). To qualify, you must be a current sophomore or junior attending either Freeman High School or Liberty High School. Each candidate will be sponsored by a local business or non-profit group in our area. Candidates will be judged on the following: application essay, judges interview, impromptu question and overall decorum. It is important that each candidate presents herself professionally, can speak well publicly and has knowledge of the SE Spokane County fair activities and events. Contestant punctuality, courtesy, and consideration to everyone is of primary importance at all times.

Participation Rules

1. Participant/Contestant must be at least a sophomore in high school or be sophomore-level homeschooled and of the equivalent age.
2. Maintain at least a C average grade point during the school year.
3. Participants/Contestants must be able to give assurance that they will remain part of the community they represent and be able to reign as Royalty for the duration of the term.
4. Participant/Contestant agrees that they will attend as many of the events as they can and will give at least 1 week's notice if they can not participate in an event. Punctuality is expected and a necessary part of the court's duties.
5. Two unexcused absences will result in the dismissal from the court and forfeit of scholarship.
 - a. Unexcused absence is defined as:
 - i. Notification of inability to attend any event less than 72 hours can be considered an unexcused absence.
 - ii. No showing an event without notice.
 - iii. Arriving at an event inappropriately attired and not ready to participate.
6. Participant/Contestant understands that certain events are mandatory and that Royalty duties are important. Each participant/contestant is expected to be available and present for scheduled and agreed-upon events. Exact dates and event details will be provided before the season.

Mandatory Events

- a. Fairfield Flag Day in June
- b. Rockford Car Show in August
- c. SE Spokane County Fair in September

7. Participant/Contestant punctuality, courtesy, professionalism, kindness and consideration to everyone is of primary importance at all times. The court is expected to maintain mature decorum at all times.
8. Participants/Contestants will not use illicit drugs and / or chemicals, tobacco and or alcohol as grounds for immediate dismissal from the court.
9. Parental support and attendance is encouraged at any/all events. There might be time when a parent is asked to stand in for the Director/Chairman.

Participation Rules Cont.

10. The court will discuss clothing guidelines for all events as a whole, but ultimately determined by the Director / Chairman and Board. Outfits may change from year to year depending on the theme of the Fair, choices of the court and desires of the Board. Each member of the court will be expected to participate in the choosing of the outfits and follow the guidelines set by the Director/Chairman. Each member of the court will be expected to show up to each event, dressed and ready to participate in the event.

- a. Jeans will not have rips or tears
- b. Dresses will be in good tastes for teen age girls and the Director/Chairman has the final say
- c. Shopping will be done as a group and outfits agreed upon as a group
- d. Director/Chairman has final say on all outfits and amount of amounts necessary for the season

11. An appropriate chaperone will be furnished by the Royalty Committee to each event and transportation arrangements will be discussed so that all parties will be made aware who is traveling with whom and when.

12. At the beginning and end of each event, each member of Royalty will be expected to check in and out with the Director/Chairman.

The SE Spokane County Fair Board of Directors and the Royalty Committee reserve the right to terminate an member of the Fair Court due to non-compliance with any of the rules above and for any circumstances that may not be written but come to light over the course of the reign of the court that the Board finds objectionable. Any and all decisions made by the Director/Chairman and the Board are final. Any Royalty terminated will reimburse the fair for expenditures.
