SAM STRAHAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship was established in the fall of 2017 to honor the life of Sam Strahan, and to continue his legacy of integrity, generosity and community involvement. The Sam Strahan Memorial Scholarship is an annual, merit-based competition, that focuses on rewarding high school seniors with a background in civic involvement and community service. This is a one-time award of \$1000. All **Freeman High School** seniors pursuing higher education are encouraged to apply. Assisting others in making their dream of attending a college, university, or trade school a reality is the main goal of the scholarship committee. One recipient will be chosen with a one-time award, selected in May.

Applicants must mail all required information to the PO Box listed at the bottom of this document.

TO QUALIFY

1. A cover letter including applicant's name, phone number, email address and name of intended college or university.
2. Submit a written essay stating how applicant demonstrates a strong commitment to improving the quality of life for people in their school, community and/or world at large through their community service.
3. In memory of Sam Strahan's spirited and outgoing personality, include a playful or goofy picture of themselves.
4. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation
5. Receipt or acceptance letter from accredited or approved school of higher education
6. Be eligible for graduation
7. Attend Freeman High School

BASIS FOR SELECTION

1. Selection shall be made by members of the Sam Strahan Memorial Scholarship Committee
2. Rating shall be based on inclusion of all qualifying items listed above.

Essays are due May 14th and will be judged by a panel of individuals. The judges' decisions are final. No discussions or rationale for their decision will be given. Essays must be original and written by the applicant.
