## Southeast Spokane County Fair Royalty Rules for Participants

- 1. Contestants must be a citizen of the United States.
- 2. Contestants must be a single female, never have been married, never have given birth, and cannot be pregnant.
- 3. Contestants must be a sophomore or junior in high school, or be home schooled and the equivalent age. They must also have at least a C average in school.
- 4. Contestants must be able to give assurance that they will remain in the community and be able to reign as Royalty for the duration of the term.
- 5. Contestants must attend any function that is required by the Royalty Committee.
- 6. It is mandatory that chosen Royalty attend all three days of the Southeast Spokane County Fair and all promotional events, including parades. The Fair dates are September 25, 26, 22 (A tentative schedule of events which require attendance is enclosed in this packet). Punctuality is expected and a necessary part of the responsibilities.
- 7. Courtesy and consideration to everyone will be of primary importance at all times. The court members are expected to conduct themselves at all times befitting the Fair Royalty, be well groomed, gracious and courteous.
- 8. Use or possession of illicit drugs and/or chemicals, tobacco and or alcohol is grounds for immediate dismissal.
- 9. Improper behavior, public displays of affection, physical and emotional threats will not be tolerated.
- 10. Royalty duties are important. You will be expected to be available for scheduled events or you will forfeit your right to continue. If you are going to miss an event you must notify the Royalty Committee immediately. Two unexcused absences will result in dismissal from your reign.

An unexcused absence will be any absence defined as untimely or late notification to attend an event, or not attending an event, coming inappropriately attired to an event, etc. (Less than 72 hours is considered late notification).

11. Clothing guidelines for all events will set by the Royalty Committee. Each member of the Royalty Court will be expected to follow the guidelines for every event. If you come to an event dressed inappropriately you will be sent home and the event will be considered unexcused.

- 12. A chaperone will be furnished by the Royalty Committee for all events. Royalty are to remain under the chaperone's supervision traveling to, during, and returning from all events. If you wish to make other arrangements regarding transportation home from an event, the chaperone will need written permission at 24 hours prior to the scheduled event. You will not be released to anyone who has not been named in the note.
- 13. During the fair, when you are on the fairgrounds, you must sign in the Fair Office and upon departing, you must sign out. Upon check in you must review your daily schedule with the chaperone for last minute changes. Prior to leaving the fairgrounds check with the chaperone for any changes in the next day's schedule.
- 14. These rules will remain intact throughout the reign of the Fair Court.

The Southeast Spokane County Fair Board of Directors and the Royalty Committee reserve the right to terminate any members of the Royalty Court due to non-compliance with the above stated rules for circumstances found to be objectionable by the Board/Committee. The decision of the Committee/Board is final. Any royalty terminated will reimburse the fair for expenditures.
