Lawn Mower Drag Race Rules & Requirements
PLEASE WORK WITH TRACK OFFICIALS TO MAKE THIS A FUN EVENT – ALL WORKERS
ARE VOLUNTEERS

Personal Protection Equipment *PPE must be worn at all times while racing.**

- Helmet. Full face is recommended. No Bicycle or ski type helmets.
- Eye Protection is required, goggles or safety glasses.
- Long pants or coveralls. Long sleeves recommended.
- NO open-toed shoes will be permitted.
- Gloves optional.

Racing Rules

- Carts will be subject to a general safety inspection by event organizers.
- It is the racer's responsibility to make a safe clean pass. We all have jobs and responsibilities outside of racing to attend to, please be respectful and safe.
- Flash light starts.
- If you jump the start light you scratch and lose that race.
- Racing by radar speed or by number of engine cylinders.
- If you exceed the speed limit in your class, you lose the race. This number should be determined in the qualifying.
- If any cart crosses the center of the race track it is an automatic loss.
- Stay in your lane after the finish line to "run out your speed". Do not cross into your opponent's lane.
- After each race, carts shall return to the pit area in a controlled manner in single file fashion.

Cart Requirements

ALL CARTS MUST HAVE A TETHERED IGNITION KILL SWITCH & CLAMPED FUEL LINES!

- Maintain some resemblance of a mower. Hood, fenders, running boards, seats
- should remain. Mower decks should be removed or cut in half and welded back
- to the running boards.
- No sharp or protruding objects.
- Try to come with a clever name for your cart!

Classes

These class standards are a list of minimum expectations to meet and a guide to try and limit kart builds for competitive racing. As usual rules will be bent or creatively interpreted.

Mow Whatcha Know, Stock

- No Modifications.
- Blades removed.
- Bagger removed.

Mow-Tor Head, Stock Modified & Super Modified

- Vertical shaft engines. single, twin or opposed engines.
- Stock transmission from a riding lawn mower.
- FULLY BELT DRIVEN.
- Tethered ignition kill switch.
- Spring return throttle.
- Fuel lines must have clamps.
- Welded front axle to frame at the axle pivot.
- Remove the deck or cut it in half and weld it back to the running boards.
- Gearing modified to suit the track (200 feet).
- Stock lawn mower tires.
- Regular gasoline.
- No power adders. no turbos, no superchargers, no camshafts, no NOS. Carburetor and exhaust modifications are allowed.
- Stock riding lawn mower frames. Any modifications must be done to a stock frame.
- No suspension
- No angle drive or chain drive modifications.
- Hand or foot throttling allowed.
- Think drag racing for any additional modifications!

Outlaw

- Spring return throttle.
- All fuel lines must be clamped.
- Any engine of choice.
- Chain, belt, jack shaft, angle drive boxes welcomed.
- Tethered ignition kill.
- No suspension.
- Deck removed or cut in half and welded back to cart.
- Welded front axle at axle pivot.
