Rules

1. No Burn-outs or wheelies will be allowed during the parade.
2. No intoxicants will be allowed during the parade.
3. All horse entrants must furnish their own clean-up crew and equipment
4. Floats must be in position no later than 9 am to give adequate time to judges.
5. No parking is allowed in the staging area, other than parade entries.
6. Max speed is 5 MPH.

- Registration tables will be on Emma Street and South Weaver Street in the parking lot.
- All entries must check-in at the registration table starting at 8 am and ending at 9:30 am.
- Buses and cars may unload at Pine Street but then must move out of the parade area and park in the bus parking area located at the baseball park located on south 1st street south of the gas station.
- Please be aware that all roads into downtown Rockford will be closed by 9 am.
