Subject: Safety Guidelines and Updates

Dear GIA Member,

The GIA Board of Directors and our GIA Director of Safety (Ronnie Mowery) have recently been made aware of safety issues which need to be addressed. We want everyone to understand that we take the safety of our Airpark seriously, as we **all** have a responsibility to be safe:

With the recent increase in the number of dogs on the Airpark, as well as active aircraft, it is critical that they are restrained and not roaming the taxiways or runway. We have discussed this previously in several Association Meetings, and remind all members to abide in accordance with our Covenants 6.09 "... all dogs must be restrained by fence or other appropriate protective restraint", and our By-Laws Section IX "pilots/aircraft owners ... responsibilities include all homes, property, each and every community member – adults and children, visitors, personal property, **pets**, and wildlife".

Likewise, with the increase in vehicle and pedestrian traffic on our private roads, we have recognized a safety issue with excessive speeding. In light of this, we will be posting speed limit signs for 25 MPH on all airpark roads: Upwind Leg, Downwind Leg, and Final Approach. This will govern ALL vehicles, including members, trash pick-up trucks, school buses, delivery trucks, and all workers and visitors given access to our Airpark.

We continue to operate our "Neighborhood Watch" for everyone's protection and welfare, and appreciate everyone's involvement. We all agree that we have something very special here at GIA, and we need to do all possible to keep everyone and their pets safe from harm.

This is an opportunity to make corrections now, and avoid serious accidents and injuries. We appreciate as always your participation, and are available to discuss further at your convenience.
