February 2020 : a fun volunteer day out to paint classrooms at Whanyinna Nursery & Primary school in Makoko, Lagos. We painted 8 classrooms, computer lab & library. 





May 2020: a COVID 19 initiative to feed + teach primary 1 – primary 6 Whanyinna Nursery & Primary School students in Makoko, Lagos. We purchased 150 units of FM Radio, 300 bags of 5kg Rice, 150 Cartons of Indomie Noodles and 250 units of locally made face mask Our students tuned into lessons broadcasted by Lagos State Government. Project TutorED

July 2020 : In partnership with Evergreen Initiative, provided virtual learning aides for 40 children, commissioned 3 skill acquisition centres in the community and empowered 24 artisans with capital, skills and working materials to thrive economically.





School Resumption

September 2020: We supported Whanyinna Nursery & Primary School in Makoko, Lagos school's reopening with Wash-hand basins, Hand Sanitizers, Thermometers, Face Shields, Masks, Water Dispensers, First-Aid Kit, Whiteboard, Whiteboard markers, stationaries and learning materials.





CITIZEN REBUILD

November 2020: SheBuildsLives in conjunction with MOE+ Art Architecture, One Voice Nigeria, Evergreen Initiative, other firms and networks are currently working on the Citizens Rebuild Nigeria Initiative to help communities, support social or public facilities, citizens and SMEs in need of help rebuilding destroyed or damaged infrastructure during October 2020 when the #ENDSARS peaceful protests were hijacked, allowing for violence and damage to property.
