



**TRINITY'S MISSION STATEMENT:** The purpose of Trinity Lutheran Church is to proclaim Jesus Christ to our members, our community, our world, and to the next generation.

STEWARDSHIP SENTENCES: John 3:6 – "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit." In Holy Baptism we receive a new birth: spirit from Spirit. With that rebirth we receive new desires, new lives, new purposes. To the (fleshly) world, Christian generosity makes no sense: the total minus a percentage is less than the original total. But Spirit-reborn Christians know that God's math works differently (as we might expect from the Trinity!). A blessing received from God becomes more of a blessing when it is used in generosity to bless others.

LIFE THOUGHTS IN THE CHURCH YEAR: Abortion and euthanasia aim to avoid disabilities by eliminating the persons who have them. The Christian community, on the other hand, regards persons with disabilities as reasons for rejoicing. Even the most fragile human bodies testify to the goodness of the God who created and sustains them (2 Corinthians 4:7-11). Let us declare and demonstrate how the life of Jesus manifests itself in every neighbor!



WE WELCOME YOU TO THE LORD'S HOUSE. We pray that, through His Word and Sacraments, He will richly bless you this day with forgiveness, life and salvation. To prepare for the service you may wish to use the prayers located inside the front cover of the hymnal.

**OUT OF CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS**, please be sure and turn off your cell phone before the service begins. While quiet conversation is encouraged before the service, we ask that during the ringing of the bell and the organ prelude you quietly and prayerfully prepare yourself for worship.

FOR THOSE VISITING AMONG US. You are most likely unfamiliar with our hymnal and service folder. To follow the worship service you need only the outer portion of the service folder. The inner section of the folder contains announcements and inserts that may be read later.

WE CELEBRATE HOLY COMMUNION TODAY! In the Lord's Supper the true body and blood of Jesus are received under the bread and wine for the great blessing of those who believe Jesus' words (Matthew 26:26-28). Since it is also possible to receive the Supper to our spiritual harm (1 Corinthians 11:27-29) and because communing together is an expression of fellowship and unity at the altar (1 Corinthians 10:16-18), we respectfully ask that only those who are presently confirmed members in good standing of our congregation or a sister congregation of the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod receive the Lord's Supper. If you are not communing, but would like to receive a blessing, simply kneel or stand at the communion rail and cross your arms in the form of an "X" in front of you. encouraged to speak with Pastor Tibben so he can further explain our teaching and practice of the Lord's Supper.

**ON THIS FESTIVAL OF THE HOLY TRINITY** God refers to Himself as "I" and "Us" – one God, three distinct persons, the Holy Trinity.
