-Genesis through Deuteronomy

Bible Facts

-the first five books of the Bible/the first five historical books of the Old Testament.

-often called The Five Books of Moses, the Law of Moses, the Law, Moses, the Pentateuch (Christians), Torah (Jews)

-Torah, broader in meaning—teaching, instruction, God's Word

-accounts/stories from Creation through the Exodus and the Wilderness Wandering

St. Mark 1:1-8 "John the Baptist Prepares the Way"

-The Gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God begins in the O.T.

-What John did is similar to the work of the ministry today—baptizing and preaching. How is it different?

St. Mark 1:9-11 "The Baptism of Jesus"

-Why was it important for the Spirit to descend on Jesus?

-Why was it important for the Father to affirm Jesus as His beloved, well-pleasing Son?

St. Mark 1:12-13 "The Temptation of Jesus"

-In the wilderness, tempted by Satan, with the wild animals—what does that tell you about Jesus' temptation?

-In what way did the angels minister to Jesus?

St. Mark 1:14-15 "Jesus Begins His Ministry"

-What indicated that the time was fulfilled and that the kingdom of God was at hand?

-What did Jesus preach? What did His preaching do?

St. Mark 1:16-20 "Jesus Calls the First Disciples"

-Why did Simon and Andrew immediately leave their nets and follow Jesus? Why did John and James leave their father Zebedee and follow Jesus?

-How was this much different than the way disciples were normally made?

-How did Jesus make YOU His disciple?
