

In a nation defined by both vast potential and deep inequality, the story of Dr. Precious Moloi-Motsepe stands as a beacon of possibility. From her humble roots in Soweto to becoming one of the most powerful women in Africa, Dr. Moloi-Motsepe's journey is one of vision, resilience, and undeniable impact.

EARLY LIFE IN SOWETO

Born in 1964 in Soweto, Johannesburg, Precious Moloi grew up during the height of apartheid. Despite the systemic barriers faced by Black South Africans—especially women—she was driven by a fierce ambition to rise above her circumstances. Her parents emphasized education, and Precious excelled academically.

A PASSION FOR MEDICINE

She pursued medicine at the University of the Witwatersrand, becoming a respected physician. Working as a general practitioner in underserved communities, Dr. Moloi-Motsepe was deeply moved by the public health challenges faced by women and children in poor areas. This instilled in her a lifelong passion for social justice and women's health.

FROM HEALER TO MOGUL

After marrying mining magnate Patrice Motsepe, she helped co-found the Motsepe Foundation, which focuses on eradicating poverty and empowering communities. While her husband built an empire in mining, Dr. Moloi-Motsepe carved out her own legacy in fashion, philanthropy, and women's empowerment.

In 2007, she launched AFI (African Fashion International), pioneering South Africa's high fashion industry and creating platforms for African designers to reach global markets. Through AFI, she provided jobs, mentorship, and exposure to countless creatives, proving that fashion could be a force for economic development.

CHAMPION OF CHANGE

Dr. Moloi-Motsepe is a powerful voice for gender equality. Her foundation funds scholarships, supports rural healthcare, and invests in young female entrepreneurs. She's served as the Chancellor of the University of Cape Town—one of Africa's most prestigious academic positions—further solidifying her commitment to education and leadership.

FROM MODESTY TO MAGNIFICENCE

The Rise of Dr. Precious Moloi-Motsepe

In 2020, she was listed among Forbes Africa's 50 Most Powerful Women, and she continues to be a regular keynote speaker at international forums, including the World Economic Forum and the UN.

A LASTING LEGACY

From her Soweto roots to global recognition, Dr. Precious Moloi-Motsepe exemplifies what it means to rise from "rags to riches"—not just in material wealth, but in influence, impact, and inspiration. She has redefined what's possible for South African women, combining elegance with intellect, and compassion with action.

Her story reminds us: greatness is not born from comfort, but from courage.



There is a moment in every woman's leadership journey where she senses the call to step away from the familiar voices of advice, the comforting structure of proven rules, and even the instinct to check in before acting. It is the moment she stops deferring and starts deciding, not because she is arrogant, but because she has taken ownership, because she has stepped over a threshold into autonomy.

Autonomy in leadership is often misunderstood. It is not rebellion or isolation. It is not the absence of authority, obligation, or accountability. It is an evolving relationship with self-authorship; the choice to be the writer of the story, the deep capacity to respond wisely and courageously to the demands of one's role, without waiting for external validation or instruction.

Autonomy is not natural to all of us. Especially not for high-achieving women who have often been rewarded for being reliable, rule-following, and relationally attuned. We have been praised for getting things "right," for being considerate, for checking in, for colouring within the lines. These skills have served us well. Until they do not.

One of my clients—an exceptional, principled leader—recently stepped into a significant senior role. It was a promotion she had earned, yet the transition was not smooth. She found herself hesitating, questioning, seeking reassurance. At first glance, this looked like imposter syndrome.

But as we worked together in coaching, a more nuanced insight emerged: she was accustomed to operating within known frameworks. She loved to "know the rules," because it made her effective. But leadership at her new level had a different character. There were fewer rules, more ambiguity. There was a greater expectation for her to define the way forward, rather than simply deliver it. Her role was no longer a box to fit into, it was a on which to stand.

Through strengths-based leadership coaching, we reframed the way she viewed her role. Instead of seeing her position as a set of expectations to comply with, we began to play with the idea of a freedom charter, a mandate empowering her to shape, steer, and signal direction. In her new role she needed to stop asking permission and embrace the permission inherent in who she was being invited to be.

Leadership gave her permission. The shift was transformative. Instead of focusing on deserving autonomy, she simply needed to inhabit it.

As women in leadership, many of us need to do this work, to cut the proverbial apron strings. These strings do not connect us to mothers or mentors, but to the psychological scripts and spells that keep us dependent on affirmation, rules, or the comfort of consensus.

Autonomy demands a constructive anarchy and a break from obedience to those things that control us: perfectionism, people-pleasing, approval-seeking, even our own internalised beliefs about what a "good leader" looks like.

We all worship something. And whatever we worship, we obey. If we worship approval, we will shape our decisions to win it. If we worship control, we will avoid anything that threatens certainty.

THE COURAGE TO STAND ALONE: REDEFINING AUTONOMY IN LEADERSHIP

How women leaders grow beyond conformity, assumptions, and the urge to ask permission

If we worship the image of competence, we will silence our questions. These are not neutral dynamics. They exert power over our behaviour. They keep us small and dependent

True autonomy is not reckless individualism or destructive rebellion. It is wise self-governance. Sometimes, it means taking full responsibility for our influence and willingly holding the gravitas of our decisions without needing to share the burden or dilute authority. Sometimes it means trusting our experience, listening to our instincts, and learning to stand unwaveringly, not in opposition or defiance, but FOR better outcomes, even in ambiguity.

Autonomy also means discerning what to say no to, not for the sake of resistance, but for clarity. It means knowing what is your responsibility and what is not. Peter Block, a wise, wise organisational development practitioner says, "If you cannot say no, then your yes doesn't mean anything". For women who are collaborative, nurturing and peace-seeking, this can be hard work. But it is vital to avoid becoming overly responsible for others and lacking responsibility for ourselves.

In my work designing leadership programmes and coaching senior leaders, I have seen this playing out in important places. Important shifts do not often come from acquiring new knowledge. They often come from reframing permissions.

Leaders expand their influence and effectiveness when they realise they already have the right to lead in ways that are deeply aligned, rooted in core beliefs, and courageously autonomous.

So, as you stand at the edge of a new role, a new venture, or a great opportunity, ask yourself:

- · Where am I still asking for permission?
- What obligations or old assumptions do I need to set down?
- What would it look like to fully inhabit my role, without apology or avoidance?

Autonomy, is not a gift granted by others. It is a quality we have to claim to step into the full weight of our calling—unshielded, unshackled, unapologetic, but always wise and kind and responsible.

If you are navigating a shift in leadership, facing uncertainty in your next step, or simply feeling the stirrings of something more, now may be the time to explore your own freedom charter. 




