- vi. Other qualification recognized by Malaysia Government.
- vii. International students must have MUET (Band 2), IELTS 4.0, or other English qualification accepted by Malaysia Government for 2nd year visa renewal, and before enter into main course. Conditional offer to international students must have MUET (Band 2), IELTS 4.0.
