Privacy Statement Regarding Customer and Online User Information

This privacy notice applies to Sweetpolly's Creations (herein after referred to as "SC") website, application, service, or tool (collectively "Services") where this privacy notice is referenced, regardless of how you access or use them, including through mobile devices.
