## Ingredients:

- 1 1/4 oz Tito's Vodka
- 3/4 oz Malibu Coconut Rum
- 3/4 oz Senior Orange Curaçao
- 1/2 oz Fresh Lemon Juice
- 1 1/2 oz Fresh Pineapple Juice
- 3/4 oz Coco Lopez (Cream of Coconut)
- Lemon Wedge for rimming glass
- Ice sphere or large cube
- Garnish: Pineapple wedge

## Preparation:

- Rub the lemon wedge on the outside rim of a double Old Fashioned glass and set aside.
- Add the Vodka, Rum, Orange Curaçao, Coco Lopez and juices in a shaker with regular ice cubes and shake until well-chilled.
- Strain into the prepared glass over a large ice sphere or cube.
