Changes for 2026

- 1. The major change you will see is the addition of some adult education classes to the event. We are serving as an incubator for 2026 and 2027 for a renewed Council University of Scouting. These two years will test the interest in holding a full-scale event while providing the opportunity for parents and adult leaders to learn more about our Cub, Venturing, Sea Scout, and Scouting BSA program. Although we will share space in Natali for registration, openings, and closings, these classes will be in a separate classroom building on campus.
- 2. First aid personnel will be in both Duda and Eberly classroom buildings during the event.
- 3. We will be asking you to join us in Natali for our opening where we will introduce you to your scouts. You can then take them to the appropriate classroom.
- 4. Bring a complete BSA medical form to the event, Parts A and B. This will be returned to you after the event.
- 5. We are still looking for someone to head a Cub Scout section for our event. Each den would have 2 or 3 electives to complete on a much-shortened day.
- 6. Parent or legal guardians must provide identification before picking up their Scout. If someone other than the parent or legal guardians is involved, the usual pick-up consent form will be used.
- 7. Please submit a short bio for use in our "Meet the Instructors" section of the Event Guide. No more than 5 or 6 lines.

Basic Operations

Here are the basic operational rules which govern our event.

- 1. ALL counselors MUST have the following:
 - **❖** Be a current registered Merit Badge Counselor. The cost is \$25 in not already registered in the program.
 - ***** Take the new BSA Safeguarding Youth Protection Program.
 - **Provide your current Pennsylvania State Clearances.**
 - Links to all required paperwork can be found on the last page.
- 2. No required badges will be taught.
- 3. Class size is limited to 15 per class unless the counselor requests a smaller class.
- 4. Scouts MUST be provided with a list of prerequisites if needed for the badge.
- 5. Class sessions are 3 hours each. You need to determine if there is a separate morning and afternoon class, or a single all-day class.
- 6. Provide contact information for Scouts and be available to finish all partials.
- 7. Provide a current BSA medical to be returned after the event, sections A and B.
- 8. Parking is available behind Natali and in the lot between Eberly and Duda classroom buildings.
- 9. Please make sure you fill the allotted time for your class. You may need to add additional videos or information from the internet about the badge. There are also many PowerPoint presentations available online to aid you in this. Or you may choose to add a partner badge to your offering. For example, we offer Fingerprinting and Crime Prevention together in one 3-hour session.
- 10. A box lunch will be provided for you.
- 11. Please do not dismiss you Scouts from your class before the end of the class period. We cannot have them wander around campus unsupervised.
- 12. Please fill out all the class paperwork. This is our record of those attending and we also use it to enter the information into Scoutbook.
- 13.A map of campus will be provided for you.
- 14. Classrooms should be open at 7 am.
- 15. The buildings will be closed at 5 pm.
- 16. Please check for the most recent requirements for your badge.
