2) Clinical and SAFE Process Audit

• The audit took place from 13th to 23rd June 2022

13th – 14th --- Rwibaale Health Center

15th – 116th--- Ibanda Hospital

17th – 20th --- Nyakibale Hospital

21st – 23rd --- Rushoroza Hospital

 All sites are still doing well in the SAFE process. A few and minor gaps were identified and communicated to the concerned staff at the health facilities.

- The clinical audit the team looked at 11 points:
 - 1. Satisfactory patient assessment record
 - 2. Satisfactory notes on clinical examination
 - 3. Correct diagnosis
 - 4. Decision to delivery times <1 hr
 - 5. Used WHO check list
 - 6. Babies APGAR score recorded
 - 7. Clear detailed notes on operation
 - 8. Patients reviewed 1sthour and 6 hours post delivery
 - 9. Clear Discharge notes
 - 10. MPDR audit notes
 - 11. Doctors' Response time =1h
- All sites need constant reminders to improve on the standards of care.

3) Renovation of the Doctor's House (NNI Program House) & Extension of the Sisters' House

- Repair works on the NNI Program main house are complete. The contractor is now doing final touches on the boys quarters.
- Repair works on the Extension of the Sisters' Convent are now on tiling the bathrooms, septic tanks and manholes are complete. After tiling there will be re-painting of the entire house.
- The contractor hopes to handover the projects in two weeks' time.

4) Housing Project (Doctors and Guest Houses)

- We signed a contract with ECOMAT KONSULTS on February 22, on a design and build plan. Ground breaking was done on the same day.
- By end of June 2022 both houses were at walling level for the first floor.

5) Roads Project

- Work on roads was contracted by the Engineer of Butunduzi Town Council and the Engineer of Kyenjojo District on 2nd June 2022. Work commenced on the same date and was expected to be completed within one month.
- The district provided the machines: the Grader and the Excavator but not fueled; the wheel loader was hired by the client.
- The roads contracted are three:
 - o Rev. Sr. Theodosia community Road
 - Waste management road
 - o Hospital main entrance road.
- By the end of June 2022 the roads project was at 60% completion. All roads were opened, culvert planted and at the level of dumping marram in roads.
